DVAMEN

A full deposit of \$500 per person is required at time of registration. ACCOMMODATIONS

Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While *imagine* will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 60 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a **single room supplement charge:** \$895 for basic itinerary. We highly recommend securing a roommate, as single rooms are very limited on the cruise

ITINERARY and CHANGES:

Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, *imagine* reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms/cabin \$245/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing to *imagine* no later than 75-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger. All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. All tours are final at 90-days prior to departure. LAND ONLY:

Land Only price is \$3747 per person. Price does not include international flights. Price includes the flight from Athens to Munich. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS

In order to keep prices low, *imagine* does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. *imagine* also does not guarantee the group will be on the same flights. Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not *imagine*. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once issued. Day 1 - Tuesday, June 21: Depart U.S.A.

Embark upon your journey with an overnight flight to Athens. Prepare yourself for a lifechanging experience and get some rest on our overnight flight. Tomorrow you will be walking where the apostle Paul walked!

Day 2 - Wednesday, June 22: Arrive Athens, **Acropolis**

We arrive in Athens late morning and are met by our Greek representative, we then meet our guide and board our bus as we make our way for Athens orientation tour, time permitting, we will also include a visit to the world-renowned Acropolis, to see the Propylea, the Erechtheum and the Parthenon. We visit Mars Hill, where Paul delivered his speech on the "Unknown God." Acropolis, Parthenon and also a short walk takes us to Mars Hill, before we make our way to our hotel. Dinner and overnight are in Athens.



Day 3 - Thursday, June 23: Athens, Corinth

After breakfast we begin our sightseeing with our drive for our visit to Ancient Corinth. This is the once-glorious city near the Isthmus, where Paul met Aquilla and Priscilla and spent a year and a half preaching the Word of God. We visit the Archaeological Museum, the Forum, the Temples and the famous Bema, where Paul stood before Gallio, accused by the Jews of Corinth. Then we drive to Cenchreae, the little harbor from which Paul sailed back to Asia, thus ending his second missionary journey. Then we head back to Athens. Here, we will admire the architectural wonders of ancient Athens. Next, we see the Agora, the ancient center of the economic and public life of the city, where Paul preached to the skeptical Athenians. During our bus tour, we also see Constitution Square with the House of Parliament and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Temple of Zeus, the Old Olympic Stadium and

the Neoclassical Buildings of Athens. Dinner and overnight are in Athens.

Day 4 - Friday, June 24: Piraeus, Start Our **3-night Mediterranean Cruise**

We transfer to Piraeus to embark on our Greek Isles cruise, our "floating hotel" for the next three nights. We sail this morning from Athens to the quaint isle of Mykonos, called the island of windmills. We arrive at Mykonos, where we disembark and have time to experience the waterfront lined with shops and cafes. We stroll the charming walkways through a maze of whitewashed buildings before returning to the ship for dinner and evening activities. No excursions are included today, as we will visit the island at our leisure.



Day 5 - Saturday, June 25: Kusadasi, Ephesus &

In the morning we arrive in Kusadasi, Turkey. Excursion Included: A short drive takes us to Ephesus, where Paul spent three years during his ministry. The impressive remains of Ephesus include the Agora, the Theater, the Stadium, the Library of Celsus, the ruins of the Temple of Diana (one of the "Seven Wonders of the Ancient World") and many more. Later, we sail for the island of Patmos. Excursion Included: Here we visit the Monastery of St. John, on one of the island's highest points. From there, we walk down to the Grotto of the Apocalypse, the site of the apocalyptic Revelations of St. John the Divine.

Day 6 - Sunday, June 26: Heraklion, Crete & Santorini

In the morning, we arrive at Heraklion, Crete and disembark. Excursion Included: During this excursion, we take a short ride through the town of Heraklion and then arrive at the Knossos excavations. Here, Sir Arthur Evan's

archaeological discoveries revealed a civilization dating back to 4000 B.C., when a great empire flourished on the island of Crete. Paul left Titus in Crete and gave instructions on appointing church leaders in the towns (Titus 1:5ff). In the afternoon, we cruise to the isle of Santorini and disembark. Excursion Not included: Santorini is often referred to as the most breathtaking of all the Greek islands. The exquisite whitewashed villages, including the town of Fira, or Thira, cling to volcanic cliffs, accessible by cable-car, or mule.

Day 7 - Monday, June 27: Athens, Flight to **Munich, Germany**

We return back to Piraeus and disembark our wonderful cruise and transfer to Athens Airport for our flight for Munich, Germany. Upon arrival in Munich, we will meet our tour escort and enjoy an orientation tour as we make our way to the Oberammergau area. Dinner and overnight in the Oberammergau area.

Day 8 - Tuesday, June 28: Oberammergau **Passion Play**

Oberammergau is not only known for its World Famous Passion Play, but also for its woodcarving craft and for its colorful and attractive frescos known as Lüftlmalereien. In the morning we have time to explore the lovely village, the museum, the parish church and a woodcarving workshop. Then we should take our seat at the Passion Play Theater for the early afternoon performance. All the actors, musicians, and singers as well as the backstage staff are either born in Oberammergau or been residents for more than 20 years. Between the different scenes of the life of Jesus Christ we can admire "living pictures" - scenes from the Bible presented as still life. After 2.5 hours it is time for a dinner break, which is waiting for us in a local restaurant. After dinner, we have the opportunity to stroll around in the village and to do some shopping. Later this

evening, the second part of the play starts and will end at approximately 11:00 pm. We go back to our hotel in the Oberammergau area for overnight after the play.



Day 9 - Wednesday, June 29: Munich Airport, U.S.A.

Today we depart from Munich airport for our flight back to the USA. We return home the same day. Indeed we have experienced the Journey of a Lifetime! We visited all of the wondrous sites connected with the Bible, then capped off these unforgettable experiences with the most memorable presentation of Christ's great Last Week, the traditional Passion Play of Oberammergau.

*Tour members who choose not to take the optional excursions can explore the islands on their own. Optional excursion pricing is subject to change by the cruise line and is reserved/purchased in Euros directly on the cruise ship. Upgraded cabins may be available upon request at an additional cost.

*Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this brochure.
