NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:

Airfare, passports, visas, vaccinations (if required), laundry, lunches not on the tour menu (food outside the contracted menu will be billed prior to leaving the hotel or restaurant), excursions not listed, telephone/international data, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, excess baggage fees, additional airline fees after registration, travel insurance, and all other items not explicitly mentioned.

PAYMENTS & FEES:

A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is due upon registration, with a second deposit of \$500 per person required within 21 days thereafter.

Credit cards are only accepted for the initial \$500 deposit; subsequent payments must be in check, ACH transfer, bill payment, or wire transfer; **all payments are required in US Funds.**

Final payment is due no later than 120 days prior to departure.

Registrations after 120 days require full payment and may incur a \$300 late fee if received 119-90 days before departure. **Failure to make final payment by 90 days prior to departure results in automatic cancellation, forfeiture of the \$500 deposit, and potential additional fees.**

Imagine Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as *imagine*) reserves the right to impose a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the destination currency based on booking date (10/22/25).

GROUP SIZE & SUPPLEMENTS:

Tour pricing assumes a minimum group size of 26 passengers.

Smaller groups may incur supplements:

- \$295 per person (25-20 travelers)
- \$395 per person (19-15 travelers)

Tours with fewer than 15 travelers may be canceled due to insufficient participation.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is based on double occupancy (two people sharing a room). Single rooms may be smaller than double rooms and, when available, incur an **additional supplemental charge of \$1,698 for the basic itinerary.** Roommates are assigned if available; otherwise, single-room occupancy may apply. *Roommates may be assigned as late as 120 days prior to departure when applicable.*

ITINERARY & CHANGES:

imagine reserves the right to adjust itineraries due to airline schedule changes. Changes requiring extra nights incur \$195 per person per night (\$295 for single rooms). You will be notified in writing of said changes when possible. Meals for additional overnights are not included. Changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing no later than 120 days prior to departure.

All deviations are subject to a \$250 administrative fee plus applicable airline fees. **All tours are made final at 90 days prior to departure.**

No changes (including additions) may be made after this time.

LAND ONLY:

Land Only price is \$5,817 per person, excluding international flights.

Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. Passengers changing from the regular tour (with group airfare) to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$195 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS & SEATING:

Flight routing is at the sole discretion of the airline, not *imagine*. *imagine* does not guarantee passengers will be on the most direct flight or flying together to the final destination (especially prior to 120 days of departure). Flights are economy class on IATA/ARC carriers with non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more. Due to group rates, *imagine* does not participate or allow passengers to use points, miles, or other airline-related offerings on group contracted airfare. Seating requests are at the discretion of the applicable airline and cannot be guaranteed. All requests, including seating, dietary restrictions, and all other accommodations must be made in writing prior to 120 days of departure. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after 120 days prior to departure will incur additional fees. Individual ticketing fees/deposits may apply in certain situations. **These fees**

can be up to \$2,000 per person and will be applied to your final balance.

FLIGHT TIMES:

All flight times are subject to change without notice. *imagine* is not liable for expenses resulting from flight delays or changes. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend obtaining a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

PASSPORTS & VISAS:

Passengers must ensure their **passports are valid for at least six months beyond the return date of their trip** and submit a valid passport copy to our office no later than 120 days prior to departure. Visa requirements vary by country, and it is each passenger's responsibility to obtain necessary visas prior to travel. *imagine* is not liable for obtaining any required travel visas.

TRIP RESCHEDULING:

imagine and/or the group leader/organization reserves the right to reschedule the trip to **future dates and/or a different destination** due to governmental action, pandemics, wars, or other circumstances beyond their control. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates or to the updated destination may transfer to another tour within one year of the original travel dates, subject to fees of up to \$300 per person, plus any applicable fees imposed by ground operators, airlines, or other vendors.

CANCELLATION FEES:

Passengers cancelling from the day of registration up to 121 days prior to departure **will be charged a \$500 administrative fee** plus any airline penalties, if applicable. If passenger cancellation forces a roommate into a single room, the canceled passenger may be charged the single room fee. **(see Accommodations)**

The following charges also apply: (plus airline fees, when applicable)

- \$1,500 (120 – 91 days)
- \$2,750 (90 – 75 days)
- 85% of total tour cost (74 – 60 days)**
- 100% of total tour cost (59 days to day of departure)**

All cancellations must be submitted in writing. No refunds will be provided for unused services on or after the day of departure. We advise purchasing travel insurance. In the event *imagine* cancels the tour due to insufficient participation, a \$200 administrative fee per passenger will be deducted from any applicable refund, plus any airline penalties.

Changes to the tour cannot be made within 90 days of departure, as the tour is considered closed at that time.

STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY:

This agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the passenger, their travel agent, the tour host, and the tour operator. The ITINERARY

Day 1 – Tuesday, February 16: Depart U.S.A.

Embark upon your journey with an overnight flight to Tel Aviv. Prepare yourself for a life-changing experience and get some rest on the flight. Tomorrow you will be walking in the footsteps of Jesus.

Day 2 – Wednesday, February 17: Arrive in Tel Aviv

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv, arrange your own transportation to the hotel, located on the beautiful coast of the Mediterranean Sea. If you have time, you might want to stop off in Old Jaffa, the traditional home of Simon the Tanner and the port from which Jonah sailed to Tarshish.

Day 3 – Thursday, February 18: Caesarea, Megiddo, Mt. Carmel, Nazareth, Cana, Galilee

After a delicious breakfast, we depart for the Galilee to visit biblical sites at Caesarea Maritima, where Peter proclaimed the Good News to a Roman Centurion (Acts 10). Next, we visit Megiddo, overlooking the Jezreel Valley (the site of the future Battle of Armageddon) and Mt. Carmel, where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Then, we continue to Nazareth (Jesus's childhood home) and Cana (location of Jesus's wedding miracle, John 2). We arrive in Tiberias for dinner and overnight near the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 – Friday, February 19: Galilee, Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Primacy of St. Peter, Ancient Boat, Sea of Galilee Boat Ride, Magdala, Jordan River Baptisms

Nothing compares to watching the sunrise over the Sea of Galilee. We begin today reflecting and worshipping at the Mt. of Beatitudes and then head toward Capernaum, Jesus's base for His early ministry. Then, we visit Tabgha (traditional site of the feeding of the 5000) and the Church of Primacy of St. Peter. Our lunch stop includes the option of ordering the special St. Peter's Fish (cost not included). After lunch, we visit an ancient boat believed to be from the time of Jesus, found in the Sea of Galilee in 1986. Then, we board a replica wooden "Jesus boat" to set sail ourselves on the Sea of Galilee. Next, we visit Magdala to see another ancient synagogue that dates to the time of Christ. We will end the day at the baptismal site of "Yardenit" on the Jordan River (baptismal kit can be purchased at the site). Dinner and overnight are at Gomeh Hotel, Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 – Saturday, February 20: Mount Arbel, Beit Shean, Jerusalem, Mount Scopus, Shepherd's Field, Manger Square, Church of the Nativity, Bethlehem

After breakfast, we start the day with a visit to Mount Arbel for a spectacular view of the Sea of Galilee and the Plain of Gennesaret. Then, we head south to Beit Shean, one of the best-preserved Decapolis Roman cities. This is where King Saul and his son's bodies hung from the city walls after the Philistines defeated the Israelites (1 Samuel 31:10-12). Then, get ready to ascend the breathtaking holy city, Jerusalem, remembering the Songs of Ascent (Psalm 120-134). We stop at Mount Scopus for a magnificent view of Zion. Next, we stop for lunch at the Tent Restaurant (cost not included) on our way to Shepherd's Field, where we remember the Christmas story. We finish the day with a visit to Manger Square and the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem. That afternoon, we check into the exquisite King David Hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 – Sunday, February 21: Guest Speaker, City of David, Israel Museum, Model City, Memorial to the Holocaust at Yad Vashem

We begin the day with breakfast at the King David Hotel and then time with a guest speaker following breakfast. We then depart for the City of David to view the archeological evidence that reveals what life was like during the reigns of Israel's greatest kings, David and Solomon. After lunch, we will visit the Israel Museum and view the fascinating 1:50 scale model of Jerusalem as it would have appeared in Jesus' time. Next, we will visit the Memorial to the Holocaust at Yad Vashem, followed by some free time to explore the city on your own, or enjoy the pool and spa (cost not included) at the hotel. After dinner, enjoy the Night Spectacular Sound & Light Show at the Tower of David Fortress, and then return for a luxurious night of rest at the King David Hotel in Jerusalem.

Day 7 – Monday, February 22: Temple Mount, Western Wall, Western Wall Tunnel, Church of St. Anne, Pool of Bethesda, Mount of Olives, Palm Sunday Walk, Dominus Flevit, Garden of Gethsemane, Dinner with Local Family

After breakfast, we begin the day visiting the Temple Mount, the 35-acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Samuel 24:18-25), and the place where Abraham built an altar to sacrifice his son Isaac (Genesis 22). This area is also the third holiest shrine in Islam, where we will find the El-Aqsa Mosque and the magnificent Dome of the Rock. From there we enter Jerusalem through the Zion Gate and proceed to the Western Wall Tunnel to see the excavations that are taking place there. We enter the Old City through the St. Stephen's Gate (Lion's Gate) to the Muslim Quarter, visit the beautiful and acoustic Church of St. Anne, and the Pool of Bethesda. Later we enjoy a magnificent view of the Old City from the Mount of Olives, enjoy the "Palm Sunday Walk," visit Dominus Flevit Chapel and weep with Jesus, and then stop for prayer and reflection in the Garden of Gethsemane. We attend a private dinner in an authentic Jewish home with a local host family. Overnight is in Jerusalem.

Day 8 – Tuesday, February 23: St. Peter Gallicantu, (Caiaphas's House), Southern Steps, Upper Room, Old City, Via Delarosa, Church of the Holy Sepulcher, Garden Tomb

We begin our final day of touring in Jerusalem at St. Peter Gallicantu (Caiaphas's House), make our way to the Southern Steps of the Temple, and then arrive at the Upper Room. We enter the Old City at Stephen's Gate (Lion's Gate) through the Muslim Quarter and walk along the Via Delarosa. We experience Stations of the Cross and visit the Sisters of Zion where we see the pavement where Jesus stood while Pilate put Him on trial. Along the way we see the Ecce Home Arch and the Ancient Cardo. Then, we visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, followed by some free time in the Old City for shopping. We finish touring with a visit to Golgotha (Gordon's Calvary) and the empty Garden Tomb, with a special communion service. Dinner and overnight are at the King David Hotel in Jerusalem, with final words from Dr. Ron Jones and time to share our memories, plus overnight rest.

Day 9 – Wednesday, February 24: Depart Israel, Arrive in U.S.A.

In the early morning, we will transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our flight back to the U.S.A. We arrive back in the U.S.A. at the close of an unforgettable tour. We take home a renewed faith, confidence in the Holy Scriptures, wonderful memories with friends, and a fresh understanding of the life and ministry of Jesus Christ.

Day 9 – Wednesday, February 24: Jerusalem, Tel Aviv for Flight to Cairo, Flight to Luxor

We depart Jerusalem and continue to Ben Gurion Airport for our short flight to Cairo. Upon arrival, we meet our Egyptian representative and tour guide. Then we change planes for a short flight to Luxor, which is known as the "Heart of Egypt." Depending on flights, time permitting we will begin our sightseeing with a tour of classical Luxor, the East Bank, which includes the Luxor Temple. Dinner and overnight are in Luxor.

Day 10 – Thursday, February 25: Luxor, Valley of Kings & Queens, Temples of Medinet Habu, Hatshepsut, Felucca Boat Ride on Nile River, Temple of Karnak

After breakfast, we begin our sightseeing of the West Bank to see the Valley of the Kings and Queens, Medinet Habu Temple, Hatshepsut Temple, and Colossi of Memnon. We will then cross back to the east side of the Nile River on a felucca boat and enjoy a late lunch (included) at Sonesta Luxor Hotel. We then end the day with a visit to the massive Karnak Temple. Dinner and overnight in Luxor.

Day 11 – Friday, February 26: Cairo, Egyptian Museum

Following breakfast, we drive to the Luxor Airport for our flight back to Cairo. Our sightseeing tour of Cairo includes a wonderful visit to the world-famous Egyptian Museum. This new museum contains unbelievable artifacts from the past, including the treasures of King Tutankhamen. If you wish, you will have time to also visit the mummy room (for an extra fee). We then drive to our hotel for dinner and overnight in Cairo.

Day 12 – Saturday, February 27: Memphis, Sakkara, the Pyramids, Sphinx

Following breakfast, we drive to Memphis, the capital of the Old Kingdom of Egypt. We see the Alabaster Sphinx and an impressive statue of Ramses II. Nearby, we'll include a visit to the Necropolis of Sakkara, containing the funerary monuments from various periods of Egyptian history. We view the Step Pyramid of King Zoser and several mastabas (tombs of nobles), including the tombs of Ti and Ptah, some of the most notable excavations of Egypt. After lunch, we visit the Great Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx. You will have the opportunity to go into one of the pyramids. We will also enjoy a panoramic view of the pyramids, and if you like, on the back of a camel (not included). We return to our hotel for dinner.

Day 13 – Sunday, February 28: Depart Cairo, Arrive Back in the U.S.A.

We transfer early in the morning to Cairo International Airport for our flight home.

While we do our best to ensure that all items listed in your itinerary are included, there are times when conditions beyond our control may affect your program or itinerary, including but not limited to air carrier changes, delays, weather, political climate, time constraints, or changes made by your tour leader and tour guide.
