INCLUDED IN PRICE:

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:
Not included in your package are passports, visas, COVID-19 tests, vaccinations, laundry, lunches, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portorage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, and all other items not specifically mentioned.

PAYMENT:
A full deposit of \$500 per person is required at time of registration. Final payment must be made in the form of a check (**credit cards are only accepted for initial deposit, any remaining payments must be in check form**) and is due no later than **100-days prior to departure**. Registrations received after 100-days prior to departure **must be accompanied by full payment**. **There may be a late fee of \$195 for all payments or new registrations received 90-75 days prior to departure**. All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 20 passengers for prices to be valid. The following supplements may apply for smaller groups: 19-15 travelers, a \$150 per person supplement; 14-10 travelers, a \$195 per person supplement. If group size is less than 10 travelers, the tour may be cancelled due to lack of participation. **If final (full) payment is not received by imagine Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as imagine) 75-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 will be forfeited and additional fees may apply.** *imagine* reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the shekel or euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date (12/01/22) when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church. All payments are required in US Funds.

ACCOMMODATIONS:
Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While *imagine* will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 75 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a **single room supplement charge: \$875 for basic itinerary; additional \$550 for optional extension.**

ITINERARY and CHANGES:
Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, *imagine* reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. **Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/ or departure city listed, by the passenger, must be provided in writing to imagine no later than 100-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger.** All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. **All tours are final at 70-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.**

LAND ONLY:
Land Only price is \$3897 per person. Price does not include international flights. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS:
In order to keep prices low, *imagine* does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. *imagine* also does not guarantee the group will be on the same flights, particularly if registering 100 days prior to departure. Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not *imagine*. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once issued. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. *imagine* is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights, could result in different routings/air carriers. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after final payment has been made, may incur additional fees.

We strongly recommend trip insurance through Travel Guard.

VISAS:
Applicable visas will be obtained by *imagine* for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. *imagine* is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

FLIGHT TIMES:
All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. imagine is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

CANCELLATION FEES:
Any passenger cancelling from the day of registration to 100 days prior to departure will be charged a \$300 non-refundable administrative fee per person plus any airline penalties, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 75 days prior until the date of departure. The following charges also apply: 99-75 days = **\$500**; 74-55 days = **\$1950**; 54-41 days = **75% of total cost**; 40 days to day of departure = **100% of total cost**. **All cancellations must be received in writing. On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance.** If *imagine* cancels the tour due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$200 deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees plus any airline penalties if applicable. No changes may be made to the tour within 70-days of departure, as the tour is officially closed.

TRIP RESCHEDULING:
imagine and/or Trip leader reserve the right to re-schedule the dates of the Trip to future dates TBD due to governmental action, pandemic, or other circumstances beyond their control. Should that occur, all travelers will be rebooked for the new dates. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates may cancel their participation and will be assessed a cancellation fee of up to \$300 per person, plus any additional penalties/fees imposed by ground operator(s), airlines, or other vendors. Travelers can transfer to another available tour up to one year from their original departure date.

PASSPORT:
Each passenger is responsible for making sure that they have a **valid passport that has an expiration date at least six months after the date of return from their trip**. A copy of your valid passport must be submitted to our office by 100 days prior to departure.

Day 1 – Tuesday, November 28: Depart U.S.A.

Tour members meet for our flight to Israel, the incomparable Land of the Bible. After dinner is served, sit back and relax, enjoying the on-board entertainment as you prepare for this exciting adventure of a lifetime, walking where Jesus walked.

Day 2 – Wednesday, November 29: Arrive Tel Aviv, Galilee

We arrive in Tel Aviv where we are met by our agent who assists us through customs and security. We are then transferred to our motor coach. Time permitting, we will have a short drive to Jaffa for sightseeing. Then, we drive to our hotel by the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight.

Day 3 – Thursday, November 30: Caesarea Maritima, Megiddo, Mt. Carmel, Druze Village, Nazareth

Today, we depart for the following Biblical sites: Caesarea Maritima, where Peter proclaimed the Good News to the Roman Centurion (Acts 10), Megiddo, and Mt. Carmel, where Elijah prayed, and God defeated 450 prophets of Baal with fire from heaven (1 Kings 18). Time permitting, we'll stop at the Druze Village for a short lunch break (not included). From here, we continue to Zippori and Nazareth (Luke 1 & 2), including a visit to "Nazareth Village" with detailed explanation of what it might have been like during the time of Jesus. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight on the shore of the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 – Friday, December 1: Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Jesus Boat, Boat Ride on Sea of Galilee, Jordan River

There is nothing quite like watching a sunrise from our hotel on the Sea of Galilee in the morning. We begin our sightseeing with our first stop at the Mt. of Beatitudes (Matthew. 5-7), with time for reflection and worship, where we will have a walk down from the mount. From here, we make our way to Capernaum, Jesus' base for His early ministry. We will visit the recently excavated "Jesus Boat" which is believed to have been built during the time of Jesus. We then board a present time replica wooden "Jesus Boat" for our Boat Ride on the Sea of Galilee. Next, we stop for lunch, with the option of the special, traditional St. Peter's Fish (not included). Afterwards, we see Gadara and then make our way to the Jordan River with the opportunity to step into that special river. Optional Baptism in the Jordan River will be available for those interested. We will have dinner and overnight in Tiberias.



Day 5 – Saturday, December 2: Golan Heights, Caesarea Philippi, Tel Dan, Tabgha, Gideon Springs, Beit Shean, Mt. Tabor, Galilee

After breakfast, we travel north for the Golan Heights to lookout over the area at an incredible sight. Then, we head to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter confessed, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living

God" (Matthew 16:13-16). We embark on a short hike to Tel Dan to see the altar of Jeroboam. Then, we stop at Tabgha, the Church of Peter Primacy. Afterwards, we make our way to Gideon Springs from the story in the book of Judges, where Gideon tested his soldiers to drink from the water from Harod Springs. Next, we visit Beit Shean, one of the best-preserved Decapolis Roman cities. In Beit Shean, the bodies of King Saul and his sons were hung from the city walls (1 Samuel 31:10-12) after they were defeated by the Philistines. From here we make our way to Mt. Tabor to visit the Monastery and take in a spectacular view. We return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 – Sunday, December 3: Jericho, Ein Gedi, Qumran, Masada, Dead Sea - Swim/Float, Jerusalem

After our breakfast, we begin our day of sightseeing traveling south toward the Dead Sea. En-route we will make our first stop in Jericho (conditions permitting). Afterwards, we continue southward for a visit to Ein Gedi where David hid from King Saul. From here we make our way to Qumran and the settlement of the first century sect known as the Essenes, authors of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Following the road south along the western shore of the Dead Sea, we will visit Masada. Here we will ascend the wilderness mountain by way of the cable car to the fortress built by King Herod. Next, we survey the ruins of the fortifications, waterworks, synagogue, temples and palaces. Time permitting, we will make a special stop at the Dead Sea (the lowest spot on the earth) for a short swim/float. Please be sure you bring with you good water shoes, as the bottom surface can be rough on your feet. We leave the Dead Sea area for Jerusalem, an ascent of 4,000 feet in 13 miles. "I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord.' Our feet are standing within your gates, O Jerusalem." (Psalm 122:1- 2 NASB). Dinner and overnight are in Jerusalem.



Day 7 – Monday, December 4: Temple Mount, Mt. Of Olives, Palm Sunday Road, Garden of Gethsemane, Jewish Quarter, Southern Steps, Bethlehem, Rabbinical Tunnels

After an early morning breakfast, we begin today by entering Jerusalem through the Zion Gate, and walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the Western Wall (Wailing Wall) of Herod's temple. Beyond the wall lies the 35-acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Samuel. 24:18-25). Conditions permitting, we will have a visit to the Temple Mount. On this site now stands the El-Aksa Mosque, and the magnificent Dome of the Rock (the third holiest shrine in Islam). From the temple area, we drive to the beautiful Mt. of Olives to behold the breathtaking panorama of the Holy City. Our pilgrimage will proceed down the Old Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive grove. There we will visit the Church of Agony, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed. Then, we make our way to St. Stephen's Gate, to walk the Via

Dolorosa, including St. Anne's Crusader Church, Pools of Bethesda, the Sister of Zion Convent (to see the Pavement where Jesus stood as he was being tried by Pilate), Ecce Homo Arch, and the ancient Cardo. We continue to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Afterwards, a short walk takes us to the Southern Steps to stand on the original steps that Jesus walked on as he entered the Temple area. We conclude our sightseeing with a short drive and visit to Bethlehem. We will pass by Rachel's tomb on the outskirts of Bethlehem and visit the Church of the Nativity and the Shepherd's Field. We will have dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. After dinner, we make our way back to the Western Wall for a visit to the Rabbi's Tunnel.

Day 8 – Tuesday, December 5: Shrine of the Book, Model City, Yad Vashem Memorial, Hezekiah's Tunnel, St. Peter Gallicantu, Garden Tomb

After breakfast, we visit the Shrine of the Book Museum, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed. You will be fascinated by the 1:50 scale model of Jerusalem as it would have appeared in Jesus' time. From here we have a short drive to Yad Vashem Children's Holocaust Memorial for a visit. Next, we drive to Hezekiah's Tunnel (conditions permitting) for a visit. Be sure to bring good water shoes with you, as you will get wet walking through the tunnel. Also, bring a flashlight, if possible. From here, we make our way to the Church of Agony at St. Peter Gallicantu. Afterwards, we visit Golgotha and the Garden Tomb for time of worship and communion. Dinner and overnight are in Jerusalem.

Day 9 – Wednesday, December 6: Jerusalem, Armenian Quarter, Farewell Dinner, Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport

Today is without a planned program. It's a special opportunity to collect your thoughts; follow your whims, revisit the places of most interest to you. We will suggest several options including the Rockefeller and Hebrew Museums, displaying a wealth of archeological treasure, or a return visit to the Old City for a last look within the walls and for souvenirs, where bargaining is a must. We will enjoy our Farewell Dinner in the Armenian Quarter of the Old City, and then we transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our return flight home.

Day 10 – Thursday, December 7: Arrive U.S.A.

We arrive back in the U.S.A. at the close of an unforgettable tour. We bring with us lasting memories of the Old and New Testament, a renewal of our faith, and a greater understanding of the life and ministry of our Lord.

Day 10 – Thursday, December 7: Arrive in Egypt

Today we leave for an exciting time in Egypt. Upon arrival at Taba border, we transfer to St. Catherine for check-in, dinner, and overnight at our hotel.

Day 11 – Friday, December 8: Mt. Moussa, St. Catherine's Monastery, Fly to Cairo

This morning we meet in the hotel lobby by 2:00 a.m. to start our

day by climbing Moussa Mountain with our local guide (those who choose not to climb, can stay back at the hotel). On the southern end of the collection of peaks, is Mount Moussa (Mountain of Moses), biblically considered to be where Moses received the Ten Commandments from God. Climbing the mountain takes about 3 hours on foot following the Path of Moses – a stairway of nearly 4,000 steps - to arrive at the peak for the wonderful view of the sunrise. After enjoying the sunrise, we visit St. Catherine's Monastery, located at the foot of the mountain. The monastery is built around what is thought to be Moses' Burning Bush and is a spectacular natural setting for priceless works of art. We then transfer to Sharm El Sheikh airport for our short flight to Cairo. Upon arrival in Cairo, we transfer to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 12 – Saturday, December 9: Cairo, Great Pyramids, Sphinx, Memphis

After breakfast, we venture to visit some of Egypt's oldest sites, and enjoy a camel ride. We first visit the Pyramids of Giza. The Great Pyramid of Cheops is the largest and is comprised of 2.3 million stone blocks. We enter this pyramid and visit the King's Chamber. Nearby, we visit the Solar Boat Museum, to see an ancient Egyptian cedar wood boat dating back 4,500 years. We also visit the Great Sphinx. Then, we visit the Necropolis of Sakkara, to see King Zoser's Step Pyramid. This vast site in the heart of the desert plateau is the largest necropolis in Egypt. We end in Memphis to see the limestone Colossus of Ramses II. Here the remnants of the nation's first capital and once the most cosmopolitan city in Egypt now lie scattered in the desert. Dinner and overnight are in Cairo.



Day 13 – Sunday, December 10: Cairo

After breakfast, we enjoy a special tour of the Museum of Antiquities. The museum houses the greatest collection of Pharaonic treasures in the world, including the expansive Tutankhamen collection of golden treasures. We continue to visit the Citadel. Inside, we see the lavishly decorated Alabaster Mosque of Mohammed Ali. We continue to the famous Suspended Church, dating back to the late fourth and early fifth centuries. We then visit the Church of St. Sergius, a fifth-century Coptic church built in the cave where the Holy Family stayed. We come to the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, where Moses was saved by Pharaoh's water girl. Finally today, we stroll through the Khan El Khalili Bazaar, a bustling warren of shops where you can bargain for rugs, copper and leather crafts, and much more. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 14 – Monday, December 11: Depart Cairo, Arrive in U.S.A.

This morning we transfer to Cairo Airport for our flight back to the U.S.A. and arrive home the same day.
