PAYMENT:

A full deposit of \$500 per person is required at time of registration. Credit cards are only accepted for the initial deposit. All other remaining payments must be made in the form of a check, including final payment. Final payment is due no later than 100-days prior to departure. Registrations received after 100-days prior to departure must be accompanied by full payment. Registrations received between 90-75 days prior to departure are subect to a \$300 late fee.

Tour pricing is based on a minimum group size of 20 passengers to be valid. The following supplements may apply for smaller groups: 19-15 travelers, \$150 per person; 14-10 travelers, \$195 per person. If group size is less than 10 travelers, the tour may be canceled due to lack of participation. If final (full) payment is not received by *imagine* Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as imagine) 75-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 will be forfeited and additional fees may apply, imagine reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the shekel or euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date (02/01/24) when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church. All payments are required in US Funds.

Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While imagine will try to match roommates, we cannot quarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 75 days prior to departure. If one is not available or f you request a single room, there will be a single room supplement charge of \$1,250 for the basic itinerary; \$695 for the optional Rome extension.

ITINERARY & CHANGES:

Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, imagine reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/ or departure city listed, by the passenger, must be provided in writing to imagine no later than 100-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger. All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. All tours are final at 70-days prior to departure. LAND ONLY:

Land Only price is \$4,767 per person. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

Day 1 - Wednesday, April 2: Departure

Our journey begins when we depart the U.S.A.

Day 2 - Thursday, April 3: Arrival, Jaffa

Welcome to Israel! Upon arrival at the Tel Aviv Ben Gurion Airport, we will be met and escorted to our motorcoach to begin our adventure in the land of the Bible! Time permitting, we will include a tour of Jaffa. Dinner and overnight are in the Tel Aviv area.

Day 3 - Friday, April 4: From Sea to Sea

Today we will start at the Mediterranean and end up at the Sea of Galilee. We begin the day at Caesarea Maritima, the port city of Herod the Great. It was here that Peter proclaimed the Good News to the Centurion. Wander the ruins of the theater, hippodrome, aqueduct and more. Next we visit Mt. Carmel, where Elijah defeated the prophets of ba'al. At Megiddo, we see the layers of more than 20 ancient cities that have been excavated. The Tel overlooks the Valley of Jezreel (Armageddon). We continue to Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus to see the Church of the Annunciation, Mary's Well, Sisters of Nazareth Convent, the House of Joseph & Mary. We also stand on the Mt. of Precipice, where Jesus was rejected by those in the synagogue. Our final stop of the day will be Cana, where Jesus turned water into wine at the wedding feast. We continue to our next hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight by the Sea of Galilee.



Day 4 - Saturday, April 5: Jesus in the Galilee

Today we explore the Galilee! We start off with a drive north to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter confessed, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God". At Tel Dan, we take a short hike to see the alter of Jeroboam. On the Mt. of Beatitudes, we reflect on the Sermon on the Mount. Nearby we visit Tabgha, the traditional site of the Feeding of the 5,000. Then we explore Capernaum, the center of Jesus' early ministry. We also get to share in a very special time of worship on the water as we set sail across the Sea

of Galilee. If time permits, we will stop at Chorazim and Kursi before returning to our Galilee hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 - Sunday, April 6: South Along the Jordan

We start the morning at Beit Shean, one of the best-preserved cities of the Roman Decapolis. We stop at Gideon's Spring and continue to Shechem (modern day Nablus) and remember Jesus meeting the woman at the well. Next, we visit Shiloh, where the Tabernacle was built. We continue south and see the walls of Jericho, then visit the Qasr Al Yahud Baptismal Site on the Jordan River, where it is likely Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist, and we will have an opportunity to be baptized here. We continue to our Dead Sea hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 - Monday, April 7: Southern Wilderness & Ruins

This morning we take some time to float in the salt and mineral laden waters of the Dead Sea. Later this morning we visit Masada, the spectacular mountaintop fortress of Herod the Great, famous as the last stand of the Jewish rebellion against the Romans. Next is Ein Gedi, the oasis where David hid from King Saul. At Qumran we learn about the Essenes, the first century sect who authored the Dead Sea Scrolls. We travel north through the wilderness of Wadi Kelt and stop to look out to see St. George's Monastery. We make our way up to Jerusalem and take in our first look of the Holy City from the Haas Promenade. We check-in to our Jerusalem hotel for dinner and overnight.



Day 7 - Tuesday, April 8: Jerusalem

We start our day on the Mount of Olives where we take in a remarkable view of the city from the East. We walk down the Palm Sunday Path, stopping at the Church of the Ascension and ending at the Church of All Nations and the Garden of Gethsemane. We enter the Old City via the Lion's Gate and walk the Via Dolorosa including stops at St. Anne's Crusader Church, Pools of Bethesda, the Pavement (where Jesus stood while being tried by Pilate), and the Ecce Homo Arch. This walk takes us to the Church of the Holy

Sepulchre. We also explore the ancient Cardo. On Mt. Zion, we visit the Upper Room to reflect on the Last Supper, and then visit the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 - Wednesday, April 9: Jerusalem

We start early this morning to visit the Temple Mount (conditions permitting) where the Jewish Temple once stood. The site is now home to the golden Dome of the Rock and Al Agsa Mosque. The site is the 3rd holiest site in Islam. We then make our way to the Jewish Quarter to see the Temple Institute for a detailed explanation of the rebuilding of the Temple. We will pray alongside the Jewish faithful at the Western Wall, and explore the Southern Wall Excavations, including the Davidson Center & Southern Steps – some of which remain from the time of Jesus! We will also go underground into the Rabbi's Tunnel beneath the Western Wall for a unique perspective of the history of the Temple. Then we gather at the Garden Tomb for communion and worship. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 - Thursday, April 10: Jerusalem & Bethlehem

This morning we visit the City of David excavations, including a unique walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel. (Bring a flashlight and water shoes. Those who wish to remain dry may walk through Hezekiah's Shaft). We then visit the Pool of Siloam where Jesus healed a man on the Sabbath. This afternoon we visit Bethlehem – the birthplace of Jesus. We will gaze out over the Shepherds' Fields and enter the Church of the Nativity. We return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Day 10 - Friday, April 11: Jerusalem Free Time, Israel

Museum, Valley of Elah, Farewell Dinner, Airport We enjoy some free time this morning in Jerusalem to explore, shop on our own, or visit Yad Vashem (Israel's Holocaust memorial and museum). Then we make our way to the Israel Museum to the Dead Sea Scrolls displayed in the Shrine of the Book exhibit and the 1:50 scale model of first century Jerusalem. We visit the Valley of Elah to see the brook where David slew Goliath. After our Farewell Dinner in Jerusalem, we transfer to the Tel Aviv Ben Gurion Airport for the return flight. Extension passengers will overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 11 - Saturday, April 12: Return to U.S.A.

We return home today at the end of an unforgettable tour with a transformed faith and memories to last a lifetime!

Day 11 - Saturday, April 12: Flight from Tel Aviv to Rome, Three Fountains Abbey, Rome

We transfer in the morning to the Tel Aviv Airport for our flight to Rome. Upon arrival in Rome, you will be met by our tour escort and transferred to the city center. We'll visit: Three Fountains Abbey: tradition tells us Paul was martyred outside the walls of Rome at a place most folks have never heard of-one of the Christian sites not on the tourist maps. It is called Tre Fontane because, according to legend, after Paul's head was cut off, it bounced three times and three fountains spring up! Although the fountain story is apocryphal, the location of his death is historical. The pathway at the Three Fountains Abbey leads to the small chapel that marks the site of Paul's martyrdom. St. Paul Outside the Walls Basilica, the burial place of St. Paul the Apostle. The chapel of relics has numerous relics, the most notable of which are a set chains said to be the prison chains of St. Paul, used in the last days before his execution. At the end of the tour, transfer to the hotel for check-in, dinner and overnight.

Day 12 - Sunday, April 13: Rome, Vatican & Sistine Chapel, Trevi Fountain

Our first stop this morning is the Vatican Museum and the Sistine Chapel, the celebrated Chapel of the Popes, and the venue of the conclaves for Papal elections. It is one of the most splendid masterpieces in the history of world art and is known around the world for its magnificent ceiling, beautifully decorated by Michelangelo. From here, our next visit is to the Basilica of St. Peter, the largest church in the world, which overlooks the enormous Piazza San Pietro. After a break for lunch (not included), we tour the eternal city. Driving through the main streets of Rome, we will marvel at the monuments of this great capital. Then we stop near the Fontana di Trevi, following tradition by tossing a coin into the fountain, promising to return to Rome. Dinner and overnight are in Rome.



Day 13 - Monday, April 14: Catacombs, St. Peter in Chains, Colosseum Forum, St. John Lateran, Basilica of St. Paul

Today, we enjoy a sightseeing tour, including a special visit to the Catacombs, most famous for the early Christians who were buried here. the catacombs offer an essential contribution to early Christian art. Early frescoes and sculptures still exist in them. Those burial tunnels of Rome's early Christians are like a honeycomb beneath the consular roads out of Rome. From here we continue to St. Peter in Chains. Then we visit the Colosseum, which symbolizes the eternity of the Roman civilization, the Forum, and the Piazza Venezia, dominated by the imposing monument to Vittorio Emanuel II. After lunch (not included), we visit St. John Lateran and the "Sacred Steps." As a monk, Martin Luther climbed these steps on his knees, trying to merit forgiveness. Afterwards, we visit St. Paul's Church where tradition believes the Apostle Paul is buried, followed by dinner and overnight in Rome.

Day 14 - Tuesday, April 15: Rome, U.S.A.

We transfer in the morning to Rome Airport for our return flight back to the U.S.A. and arrive the same day.
