**THE FINE PRINT** ENROLLMENT IN AND PAYMENT OF YOUR DEPOSIT FOR THE TOUR, CONSTITUTES YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS AND STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY.

**INCLUDED IN PRICE:**

1) Round trip airfare per brochure — deluxe motor coaches — First Class / Superior Class hotels — guided sightseeing — entrance fees to sites visited — breakfast and dinner daily per brochure

2) Taxes and fuel charges totaling **\$695 USD** comprised of **\$364.60** for fuel charges (subject to increase by airline up to 30 days prior to departure) and **\$330.40** for taxes (including federal inspection fees for the U.S. Customs and Immigrations; international air transportation tax; agricultural tax; other per person taxes imposed by government entities; airport taxes and fees including the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person).

3) Gratuities of **\$195** for tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew; gratuities on ferries, and cruise ships.

**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:**

Not included in your package are passports, visas, COVID-19 tests, vaccinations, laundry, lunches, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, and all other items not specifically mentioned.

**PAYMENT:**

A full deposit of \$500 per person is required at time of registration. Credit cards are only accepted for the initial deposit. **All other remaining payments must be made in the form of a check, including final payment.** Final payment is **due no later than 100-days prior to departure.** Registrations received after 100-days prior to departure must be accompanied by full payment. Registrations received between 90-75 days prior to departure are subject to a \$300 late fee.

Tour pricing is based on a minimum group size of 26 passengers to be valid. *The following supplements may apply for smaller groups:* 25-21 travelers, \$222 per person; 20-15 travelers, \$416 per person. If group size is less than 15 travelers, the tour may be canceled due to lack of participation. **If final (full) payment is not received by Imagine Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as Imagine) 75-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 will be forfeited and additional fees may apply.** Imagine reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date (05/16/24) when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church. **All payments are required in US Funds.**

**ACCOMMODATIONS:**

Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While Imagine will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 75 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a **single room supplement charge of \$850 for the basic itinerary.**

**ITINERARY & CHANGES:**

Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, Imagine reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. **Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed, by the passenger, must be provided in writing to Imagine no later than 100-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger.** All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. **All tours are final at 70-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.**

**LAND ONLY:**

**Land Only price is \$4,850 per person. Price does not include international flights.** Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

**AIRLINE TICKETS:**

In order to keep prices low, **Imagine does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. Imagine also does not guarantee the group will be on the same flights, particularly if registering 100 days prior to departure.** Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not Imagine. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once issued. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. Imagine is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights, could result in different routings/air carriers. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after final payment has been made, may incur additional fees.

**FLIGHT TIMES:**

**All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. Imagine is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays.** If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

**PASSPORT:**

Each passenger is responsible for making sure that they have a **valid passport that has an expiration date at least six months after the date of return from their trip.** A copy of your valid passport must be submitted to our office by 100 days prior to departure.

**VISAS:**

Applicable visas will be obtained by Imagine for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. Imagine is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

**TRIP RESCHEDULING:**

Imagine and/or Trip leader reserve the right to re-schedule the dates of the Trip to future dates TBD due to governmental action, pandemic, war, or other circumstances beyond their control. Should that occur, all travelers will be rebooked for the new dates. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates may cancel their participation and will be assessed a cancellation fee of up to \$300 per person, plus any additional penalties/fees imposed by ground operator(s), airlines, or other vendors. Travelers can transfer to another available tour up to one year from their original departure date.

**CANCELLATION FEES:**

Any passenger cancelling from the day of registration to 100 days prior to departure will be charged a **\$300 non-refundable administrative fee** per person plus any airline penalties, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 75 days prior until the date of departure. The following charges also apply: 99-75 days = **\$500**; 74-60 days = **\$2,750**; 59-46 days = **85% of total cost**; 45 days to day of departure = **100% of total cost. All cancellations must be received in writing. On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance.** If Imagine cancels the tour due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$200 deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees plus any airline penalties if applicable. No changes may be made to the tour within 70-days of departure, as the tour is **officially closed.**

**Day 1 – Sunday, April 6: Depart U.S.A.**

Tour members depart on our flight to Frankfurt. After we board our flight for Europe, we will be served dinner according to the airline's schedule.

**Day 2 – Monday, April 7: Mainz**

Upon arrival in Frankfurt, we are welcomed by our tour escort who will accompany us throughout the whole tour. We board our coach and drive to the city of Mainz to get settled, relax, and enjoy some free time before our Welcome Dinner. Overnight in Mainz.

**Day 3 – Tuesday, April 8: Mainz, Worms**

We start our day with a city tour of Mainz at St. Martin's Cathedral, built in the 8th century, where seven kings' coronations took place over the centuries. Then we will visit the Gutenberg Museum, the birthplace of printing, where two copies of the world-famous Gutenberg Bible are displayed in a special vault. We will also visit its legendary library. After lunch, we make our way to Worms. Martin Luther was summoned to Worms in 1521 by Emperor Karl V in order to justify his "heretical" conduct towards the Roman Catholic Church. A guided city tour shows us St. Peter's Cathedral, one of three Imperial Cathedrals in Germany and one of the best examples of Romanesque architecture. This is the place where Luther made his "Here I Stand" declaration. We see the Church of the Holy Trinity, the oldest Jewish Cemetery in Europe, and the world's largest Memorial to the Reformation. Dinner and overnight are in Worms.

**Day 4 – Wednesday, April 9: Heidelberg, Rothenburg**

Today we drive to Heidelberg, a gorgeous and charming town on the Neckar River. We take a leisure ride on the Heidelberg Railway up to Heidelberg Castle (where the Heidelberg Confession was written in 1653). We visit the castle and the Castle Church. Then we continue to the medieval town of Rothenburg ob der Tauber where we enjoy a walking tour inside the medieval walled city without a single modern building within. We

see the Town Hall, the Glockenspiel, and explore St. Jakob's Church which holds the famous altar carving by Tilman Riemenschneider. We stop at the Medieval Crime Museum (containing instruments of torture) and end our walking tour with a visit to Kathe Wohlfahrt's Christmas Village for free time and shopping. We drive to Nuremberg for dinner and overnight.

**Day 5 – Thursday, April 10: Nuremberg**

We start our day with a city tour of Nuremberg. According to Luther, Nuremberg was "the eye and the ear of Germany" during the Reformation because there were 21 printing houses to publish news. Nuremberg's printing presses played an integral part disseminating in the Reformation, including mass-producing Luther's 95 Theses. We take a walk through the Old Town including the churches St. Lorenz and St. Sebald. Enjoy some free time exploring this charming medieval city. Dinner and overnight are in Nuremberg.

**Day 6 – Friday, April 11: Coburg, Erfurt**

Today we travel further north to Coburg to visit the famous Veste Coburg, the fortress where Luther took refuge and lived during the Augsburg Confession and one of the largest and best-preserved medieval castles in Germany. While visiting the castle, we'll see the Luther Room, the art treasures in the various collections, and the royal building with the Luther Chapel. The inside is a museum of medieval military weaponry, Venetian glassware, china, and tapestries. Afterward, we visit the historic, picturesque city. Coburg is the quintessential German town with great food, drinks, and plenty to see and do. The vibrant "Marktplatz" is the center of the Old Town and a happy, bustling place. After lunch, we drive north to Erfurt, the spiritual training ground of Martin Luther. It was here that Luther obtained a degree in 1502 and where he took the decisive step to turn to theology and the monastic life. We explore the Augustinian Monastery, with a permanent exhibit depicting Luther's life as a monk in Erfurt. Dinner and overnight are in Erfurt.

**Day 7 – Saturday, April 12: Erfurt, Weimer**

After breakfast, we enjoy a short drive to Weimer. Luther visited the city frequently between 1518 and 1540 where he gave counsel about implementing the Reformation. We tour the late Gothic Town Church St. Peter & Paul, built between 1498-1500, where Luther repeatedly preached. Now called the Herder Church, it holds the famous three-winged altar (1552-53) painted by Lucas Cranach the Elder as a major pictorial representation of the Lutheran doctrine. Then we tour The Duchess Anna Amalia Library, a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the most beautiful and historic libraries in all of Germany. It holds over one million volumes, including medieval manuscripts, pamphlets from the Reformation, and a collection of family registers and bibles (including the first complete edition of the Lutheran bible translation from 1534). Afterward, enjoy free time on your own for lunch, stroll through the park, visit Goethe's home, or explore the charming Marktplatz before returning to Erfurt for dinner and overnight.

**Day 8 – Sunday, April 13: Eisenach**

This morning, we make our way to Eisenach. We begin by visiting Wartburg Castle, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Here Luther found refuge during his exile and translated the New Testament from Greek into German. Here we will see the room where he lived and worked. Then we tour the city of Eisenach and admire all its beautiful sights, such as the Luther House and St. George's Church, where Luther preached while "on the run" and later, in 1685, Johann Sebastian Bach was baptized. We visit the Bach House, the first and most comprehensive home museum of the composer. We tour the 17th-century home and attend a small concert of Bach pieces played on baroque keyboard instruments. After lunch, we make our way to Dresden for dinner and overnight.

**Day 9 – Monday, April 14: Dresden, Wittenberg**

After an early breakfast, we tour the wonderful Baroque

city of Dresden. We begin with Germany's largest Protestant church, the Frauenkirche, which has been fully restored following damage during WWII. J.S. Bach was the first to play on the Silberman organ when the church was originally built. Luther often preached in Dresden and a statue of the reformer stands in front of Frauenkirche in the city center. A nearly 400-foot-long mural, known as the Furstenzug, or Procession of Princes, on the outer wall of the Dresden castle stables tells reveals how the movers and shakers of the day reacted to the seismic shift brought about by the Reformation. We walk along the Bruehlsche Terrasse containing sweeping views of the Elbe River. Enjoy some free time for lunch, shopping and exploring Dresden on your own, then we make our way to Wittenberg. Dinner and overnight in Wittenberg.

**Day 10 – Tuesday, April 15: Wittenberg**

After breakfast, we tour Lutherstadt Wittenberg, the picturesque town at the heart of the Reformation. When it comes to Luther, there is almost no city more important than this one. We begin at the Lutherhaus, where Martin Luther lived with Katherine Von Bora and their children, and where he held his infamous table talks. Then we visit the famous Castle Church where Luther posted the 95 Theses, which sparked the Protestant Reformation. Luther is also buried in the Castle Church. We walk through the historic center and tour the Town and Parish Church where Luther often preached and married Katherine. Afterward enjoy some free time to explore this historic, charming town. Dinner and overnight are in Wittenberg.

**Day 11 – Wednesday, April 16: Berlin**

After breakfast, we explore Berlin, the capital of the reunified Germany, on a guided tour that includes the Reichstag (Parliament) and its cupola, the Nikolai Quarter, the impressive boulevard "Unter den Linden", the Gendarmen-Market, and the Brandenburg Gate. Time permitting, we will attend a short Noon prayer service at the Berliner Dom (Berlin Cathedral) and hear its stunning organ. We will see firsthand how World War II divided Berlin, visit Check-Point Charlie and the remaining pieces of the Berlin Wall, and walk through the Holocaust Memorial to the Murdered Jews of Europe. In the evening, the group will come together for our Farewell Dinner. Overnight is in Berlin.

**Day 12 – Thursday, April 17: Depart Berlin, Arrive in U.S.A.**

We transfer to Berlin Airport for our departure back to the U.S.A. and arrive home today with a greater understanding of Martin Luther and the early Christian Church, and full of wonderful memories of the incredible once-in-a-lifetime tour to Germany.
