PAYMENTS & FEES:

A non-refundable deposit of **\$500** per person is due upon registration, with a second deposit of **\$500** per person required within 21 days thereafter. Credit cards are only accepted for the initial \$500 deposit; subsequent payments must be in check, ACH transfer, bill payment, or wire transfer; **all payments are required in US Funds**.

Final payment is due no later than 120 days prior to departure.

Registrations after 120 days require full payment and may incur a \$300 late fee if received 119-90 days before departure. **Failure to make final payment by 90 days prior to departure results in automatic cancellation, forfeiture of the \$500 deposit, and potential additional fees.**

GROUP SIZE & SUPPLEMENTS:

Tour pricing assumes a minimum group size of 20 passengers.

Smaller groups may incur supplements:

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is based on double occupancy (two people sharing a room).

The ITINERARY

Day 1 – Friday, November 20: Depart U.S.A.

Tour members meet for our flight to Israel. After dinner is served, we sit back, relax, and enjoy the onboard entertainment as we begin this exciting adventure.

Day 2 – Saturday, November 21: Ben Gurion Airport, Jaffa, Netanya

Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, we proceed through customs and meet our agent, who assists us to our motor coach. Time permitting, we stop in Jaffa before continuing to our hotel in the Netanya area for dinner and overnight.

Day 3 – Sunday, November 22: Caesarea Maritima, Mt. Carmel, Megiddo, Nazareth, Cana, Magdala, Galilee

Today, we journey north along the coast to Caesarea Maritima, where Peter proclaimed the Good News to the Roman centurion. We continue to Megiddo, an ancient city with layers of history, and Mt. Carmel, where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal. Time permitting, we stop for a short lunch break in a Druze Village (not included). Our journey then takes us to Nazareth, Jesus' childhood home, and Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle. We also visit the Mt. of Precipice before arriving in Magdala to see a first-century synagogue and visit the chapel. We conclude our evening with dinner and overnight at the Magdala Hotel on the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 – Monday, November 23: Mt. Arbel Hike, Jordan River, Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes, Boat Ride

We begin the day with an optional hike up Mt. Arbel for a breathtaking view of Galilee and a time of worship. Those who prefer not to hike may take the bus to visit the site. Afterwards, we travel to Yardenit, the Jordan River baptismal site, where we have the opportunity to reaffirm our baptism. Next, we visit Capernaum, the center of Jesus' ministry, followed by the Mount of Beatitudes, where He delivered the Sermon on the Mount. We then see the first-century "Jesus boat," discovered in 1986, before taking a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, enjoying a special time of worship. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 – Tuesday, November 24: Hippos, Beit Shean, Jericho, Dead Sea

This morning, we explore Hippos, one of the ten Decapolis cities, and recall the story of the demoniac restored by Jesus. We continue to Beit Shean, the best-preserved Decapolis city, also known as the place where Saul's body was hung. Traveling south to Jericho, we see a portion of the actual revetment wall from the time of Joshua. Time permitting, we may even climb the Tel. We end the day floating in the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth. Dinner and overnight in the Jericho region.

Day 6 – Wednesday, November 25: Masada, Ein Gedi, Qumran, Wadi Qelt, Jerusalem

This morning, we ascend Masada via cable car to explore Herod the Great's grand fortress, later used as a refuge by Jewish zealots. Those who wish may walk down the Snake Path, while others take the cable car. We continue to Ein Gedi, where David hid from King Saul, and take a short hike to the waterfalls. Next, we visit Qumran, the settlement of the

Essenes, known for producing the Dead Sea Scrolls. Those interested may hike near some of the caves where the scrolls were discovered. We end the day overlooking the Judean Desert and Wadi Qelt, where we hear the words of Isaiah 40 and Psalm 23. Finally, we ascend to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. After dinner, we offer an optional walk to the Western Wall within the Old City.

Day 7 – Thursday, November 26 – Happy Thanksgiving!: Temple Mount, City of David, Pool of Siloam, Southern Excavations, Western Wall & Tunnels

This morning, conditions permitting, we visit the Temple Mount, the sacred area purchased by King David. This site is home to the Dome of the Rock and the Al-Aqsa Mosque, significant landmarks in Islam. Continue to the City of David, where we view excavations of David's palace. Those who wish may explore Hezekiah's Shaft or take an adventurous walk-through Hezekiah's Tunnel, which still carries water. We then sit on the steps of the Pool of Siloam and reflect on the story of the blind man healed by Jesus. From there, we walk through a newly discovered Herodian drainage tunnel leading to the Southern Steps, once used by Jesus and His disciples. We then proceed to the Western Wall, Judaism's holiest site, before walking along the Western Wall Tunnels beneath the Temple Mount. before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 8 – Friday, November 27: Mt. of Olives, Palm Sunday Road, Garden of Gethsemane, Old City, Solomon's Quarry, Afternoon at Leisure

We begin with a panoramic view of Jerusalem from the Mt. of Olives, then follow the traditional Palm Sunday Road to the church of Dominus Flevit. After viewing the Golden Gate, we walk downhill to Gethsemane for a time of meditation and visit the Church of All Nations, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed before His arrest. Inside the Old City, we visit the Pools of Bethesda and St. Anne's Church, known for its remarkable acoustics. We also visit Solomon's Quarry before enjoying an afternoon at leisure in Jerusalem. After dinner, we offer an optional evening walk and time of devotion.

Day 9 – Saturday, November 28: Garden Tomb, Gehenna, Jaffa, Farewell Dinner

After breakfast we will spend a special time of worship and communion at the Garden Tomb. Next, we visit the Valley of Gehenna, historically associated with ancient offerings to false gods. In the afternoon, we travel to Tel Aviv, where participants have the option of a bike ride to Jaffa or free time to explore and shop. In the evening, we gather for a special farewell dinner at a local restaurant and return to Jerusalem for our final overnight.

Day 10 – Sunday, November 29: Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport, Return to U.S.A.

This morning, we transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our return flight home, arriving in the U.S.A. the same day. As our unforgettable journey comes to a close, we bring with us lasting memories, a renewal of faith, and a deeper understanding of the life and ministry of our Lord.

Day 10 – Sunday, November 29: Allenby Bridge, Mt. Nebo, Machaerus, Petra

We begin the day by driving south to the Jordan Valley the Allenby Bridge. Here we make the crossing from Israel to Jordan. After border formalities, we meet our Jordanian guide and bus and drive to Mt. Nebo to stand where Moses stood and viewed the Holy Land (Deut. 34). Here you can take in a breathtaking view across the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea. We continue to Machaerus, one of Herod's palace-fortresses. It was here where John the Baptist was beheaded (Mark 6). In the late afternoon, we drive south down the Desert Highway to Petra, where we spend the night. We arrive at our hotel and enjoy a late dinner together.

Day 11 – Monday, November 30: Petra, Wadi Rum

We arrive this morning at the entrance of Petra and spend the entire day within this red-rose ancient city. We are in the heart of the Seir Mountains, Land of Edomites, mentioned in the Bible in Genesis. These mountains house the Aaron Peak, the highest in Petra and the burial place of Moses' brother Aaron. A walk through the Siq, the main entrance to Petra, brings us to the first monument "The Treasury" "Al-Khazneh" a dramatic site. This well-preserved monumental tomb appears in the movie "Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade." A walk further down through the outer siq with all of its tombs and burial chamber brings us to one of the largest theaters in Jordan. A 3000-seat theater from the early first century is carved in the sandstone mountains at the bottom of the High Place of Sacrifice Mountain. Apparently, some sacrificial rituals had taken place here. From here, we walk uphill to the Royal Tombs for a great view of the lower part of Petra with all its Roman remains. There will be the option to walk to the "Monastery" of Petra and/or the High Place. Leaving the site of Petra in mid-afternoon, we drive south to Wadi Rum. Here we enjoy an amazing jeep ride in the desert. We then stay in Wadi Rum at Captain's, a Bedouin Village. We enjoy dinner together and a devotional time under the stars. It will be a unique experience!

Day 12 – Tuesday, December 1: Wadi Rum, Amman

Late morning start, we leave Wadi Rum and make our way for Amman, where we then check into our hotel for our farewell dinner and time to rest and shower as we have an early morning transfer to the Amman Airport for our return flight back home.

Day 13 – Wednesday, December 2: Amman, Arrive in U.S.A.

We have an early morning transfer to Alia Airport for our return flight back to the U.S.A. We arrive home in the U.S.A. at the close of an unforgettable tour. We take home wonderful memories of the Old and New Testament, a renewal of our faith, and a greater understanding of the life of our Lord.
