**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:**

Passports, visas, vaccinations (if required), laundry, lunches not on the tour menu (food outside of the contracted menu will be billed prior to leaving the hotel or restaurant), excursions not listed, telephone/international data, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, excess baggage fees, additional airline fees after registration, travel insurance, and all other items not explicitly mentioned.

**PAYMENTS & FEES:**

A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is due upon registration, with a second deposit of \$1,000 per person required within 21 days thereafter. Credit cards are only accepted for the initial \$500 deposit; subsequent payments must be in check, ACH transfer, bill payment, or wire transfer; all payments are required in US Funds.

**Final payment is due no later than 150 days prior to departure.**

Registrations after 150 days require full payment and may incur a \$300 late fee if received 149-120 days before departure. **Failure to make final payment by 120 days prior to departure results in automatic cancellation, forfeiture of the \$1,500 deposit, and potential additional fees.**

*imagine* Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as *imagine*) reserves the right to impose a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the destination currency based on booking date (04/28/25).

**GROUP SIZE & SUPPLEMENTS:**

Tour pricing assumes a minimum group size of 20 passengers.

**Smaller groups may incur supplements:**

- \$150 per person (19-16 travelers)

- \$195 per person (15-12 travelers)

Tours with fewer than 12 travelers may be canceled due to insufficient participation.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:**

Price is based on double occupancy (two people sharing a room). Single rooms may be smaller than double rooms and, when available, incur **an additional supplemental charge of \$1,747 for the basic itinerary**. Roommates are assigned if available; otherwise, single-room occupancy may apply. *Roommates may be assigned as late as 120 days prior to departure when applicable.*

**ITINERARY & CHANGES:**

*imagine* reserves the right to adjust itineraries due to airline schedule changes. Changes requiring extra nights incur \$195 per person per night (\$295 for single rooms). You will be notified in writing of said changes when possible. Meals for additional overnights are not included. Changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing no later than 120 days prior to departure. **All deviations are subject to a \$250 administrative fee** plus applicable airline fees. **All tours are made final at 120 days prior to departure.** **No changes (including additions) may be made after this time.**

**LAND ONLY:**

**Land Only price is \$7,647 per person, excluding international flights.** Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. Passengers changing from the regular tour (with group airfare) to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$195 per person.

**AIRLINE TICKETS & SEATING:**

Flight routing is at the sole discretion of the airline, not *imagine*. *imagine* does not guarantee passengers will be on the most direct flight or flying together to the final destination (especially prior to 120 days of departure). Flights are economy class on IATA/ARC carriers with non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more. Due to group rates, *imagine* does not participate or allow passengers to use points, miles, or other airline-related

offerings on group contracted airfare. Seating requests are at the discretion of the applicable airline and cannot be guaranteed. All requests, including seating, dietary restrictions, and/or all other accommodations must be made in writing prior to 120 days of departure. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after 120 days prior to departure will incur additional fees. Individual ticketing fees/deposits may apply in certain situations. **These fees can be up to \$2,000 per person and will be applied to your final balance.**

**FLIGHT TIMES:**

**All flight times are subject to change without notice. *imagine* is not liable for expenses resulting from flight delays or changes.** If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend obtaining a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

**PASSPORTS & VISAS:**

Passengers must ensure their **passports are valid for at least six months beyond the return date of their trip** and submit a valid passport copy to our office no later than 120 days prior to departure. Visa requirements vary by country, and it is each passenger's responsibility to obtain necessary visas prior to travel. ***imagine* is not liable for obtaining any required travel visas.**

**TRIP RESCHEDULING:**

*imagine* and/or the group leader/organization reserves the right to reschedule the trip to **future dates and/or a different destination** due to governmental action, pandemics, wars, or other circumstances beyond their control. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates or to the updated destination may transfer to another tour within one year of the original travel dates, subject to fees of up to \$300 per person, plus any applicable fees imposed by ground operators, airlines, or other vendors.

**CANCELLATION FEES:**

Passengers cancelling from the day of registration up to 151 days prior to departure **will be charged a \$500 administrative fee** plus any airline penalties, if applicable. If passenger cancellation forces a roommate into a single room, the canceled passenger may be charged their single room fee. **↓ (see Accommodations)**

**Changes to the tour cannot be made within 120 days of departure, as the tour is considered closed at that time.**

**Day 1 – Friday, August 28: Depart U.S.A.**  
Embark upon your journey with an overnight flight to **Athens/Thessaloniki**.

**Day 2 – Saturday, August 29: Athens /Thessaloniki**  
We arrive in **Athens for flight to Thessaloniki** and transfer to our hotel for check-in, dinner, and a well-deserved rest.

**Day 3 – Sunday, August 30: Neapolis, Philippi, Thessaloniki**  
In the morning, we follow the route of the **Via Egnatia** to **Kavala (Neapolis)**, Paul’s first stop in bringing the Gospel to present day Europe. Next, we travel to **Philippi** where we visit the **Baptistery of Lydia** near the river where Paul baptized her. Lydia was the first convert of Paul on European soil, followed by the jailer (Acts 16). We also visit the ruins of the **Forum of Philippi**, the “Prison of Paul,” and the Theater. We return to Thessaloniki for dinner and overnight.

**Day 4 – Monday, August 31: Thessaloniki, Berea, Aigai**  
This morning, we tour ancient **Thessaloniki**, where we’ll see the modest ruins of the city where the church received two of Paul’s epistles on his second missionary journey. We’ll see highlights from the city, including the **Roman Forum, Church of St. Demetrios, the White Tower, and the statue of Alexander the Great**. After lunch, we’ll follow Paul’s journey south to biblical Berea (Acts 17:11) where its inhabitants examined the Word to see if Paul’s words were true. Finally, we’ll explore the ruins and museum of the newly re-opened site of **Aigai**, while discussing the significance of Alexander the Great in history and prophecy. Dinner and overnight in Thessaloniki.



**Day 5 – Tuesday, September 1: Athens**  
Late this morning we board our short flight to **Athens**, where we’ll walk beneath **Hadrian’s Arch** and see the ruins of the massive **Temple of Zeus**. As our bus tour continues, we also see **Constitution Square** with the

House of Parliament and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the **Old Olympic Stadium**, and the Neoclassical Buildings of Athens. Dinner and overnight in Athens.

**Day 6 – Wednesday, September 2: Athens, Acropolis, Parthenon, Mars Hill**  
Today we’ll admire the architectural wonders of ancient **Athens** as we explore the world-renowned **Acropolis** and see the Propylea, the Erechtheum, and the **Parthenon**. We will also visit the newly renovated **Acropolis Museum**. We visit **Mars Hill**, where Paul delivered his message on the “Unknown God.” We’ll see the **Agora**, the ancient center of the economic and public life of the city. Dinner & overnight are in Athens.



**Day 7 – Thursday, September 3: Corinth, Cenchreae**  
This morning, we drive to ancient **Corinth** with a stop at the amazing **Corinthian Canal**, as well as its ancient solution, the **Diolkos**. Corinth is where Paul met Aquilla and Priscilla and spent a year and a half on his second missionary journey. We will see the **Archaeological Museum, the Forum, the Temple, the famous Bema** (where Paul stood before Gallio), and the breathtaking **Acrocorinth**. Then we drive to **Cenchreae**, the harbor from which Paul sailed back to Asia, thus ending his second missionary journey. Dinner and overnight are in Athens.

**Day 8 – Friday, September 4: Start our 3-Night Mediterranean Cruise, Mykonos**  
Let’s cruise! After a leisurely morning, we sail this afternoon from Athens to the quaint isle of **Mykonos**, called the island of windmills. This afternoon, we’ll enjoy some time together as a group in **Bible study**. After disembarking on Mykonos, we’ll have some free time to experience the waterfront lined with shops and cafes. We stroll the charming walkways through a maze of white-washed buildings before returning to the ship for dinner and overnight.

**Day 9 – Saturday, September 5: Ephesus, Patmos**  
In the morning, we arrive in **Kusadasi**, Turkey. A short drive takes us to the amazing ruins of **ancient Ephesus**, where Paul spent three years during his ministry. The impressive remains of Ephesus include the **Agora, the Theater, the Stadium, the Library of Celsus**, the ruins of the **Temple of Artemis** (one of the “Seven Wonders of the Ancient World”) and much more. After seeing where the Apostle John was buried at the **Basilica of St. John**, we’ll visit the **Turkish Rug shop**. This afternoon we’ll sail to the island of **Patmos**, where we visit the **Grotto of the Apocalypse**, where tradition says John wrote the book of Revelation. We’ll also see the **Chapel of Elijah**, the island’s highest point—from which we’ll see a **beach that John may have written about in Revelation 13**. Dinner and overnight aboard the ship.

**Day 10 – Sunday, September 6: Crete, Santorini**  
In the morning, we arrive at Heraklion on the island of **Crete**. We’ll drive south to the **Basilica of Titus in Gortyn** and read Paul’s words written to Titus in Crete. Then we’ll have a short stop at **Fair Havens**, where Paul sailed on his way to Rome. In the afternoon, we cruise to the picturesque island of **Santorini**, where we explore and shop at our leisure on one of the most breathtaking of all the Greek islands. Overnight aboard the ship.

**Day 11 – Monday, September 7: Piraeus, Homeward Bound**  
We disembark the cruise this morning in Piraeus. After disembarkation, those not doing the Rome extension will board the return flights back to the U.S.A., arriving home the same day.

**Day 11 – Monday, September 7: Rome, Catacombs, Appian Way**  
We transfer in the morning to the Athens Airport for our flight to Rome, where we are met by our agent and begin our sightseeing tour. Then we have a special visit to the Catacombs, where we explore tunnels and see the carvings on the walls from early Christians. Next, we’ll walk a short distance along the Appian Way, the very road Paul walked as a prisoner entering Rome. We’ll pass the Circus Maximus, where the great fire of AD 64 began, sparking the persecution of Christians for centuries.

**Day 12 – Tuesday, September 8: Vatican & Sistine Chapel, Roman Forum, Colosseum**  
After breakfast, our first visit today is to the ornate Vatican Museum and the famous Sistine Chapel with Michelangelo’s magnificent ceiling. Our next stop is the Basilica of St. Peter, the largest church in the world, which overlooks the enormous St. Peter’s Square, the site where Peter was crucified upside-down. We visit the Roman Forum and see the Arch of Titus, which boasts of Rome’s victory over Jerusalem. We’ll see the Basilica Julias, where Paul was likely condemned, and the Colosseum, where gladiators fought. Dinner and overnight are in Rome.



**Day 13 – Wednesday, September 9: Pompeii**  
This morning we’ll ride a train to Pompeii, where we’ll meet our tour escort and head south for the spectacular ruins. Covered by the eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in AD 79, Pompeii remained buried, preserved, and undiscovered until 1748. The excavations will provide us insight into the first-century Roman Empire of the Apostle Paul. Dinner and overnight are in Rome.

**Day 14 – Thursday, September 10: Mamertine Prison, St. Peter in Chains, Tres Fontane Abbey, Basilica of St. Paul**  
We start our day at the Mamertine Prison, where Paul was imprisoned and wrote 2 Timothy. We’ll also visit the Church of St. Peter in Chains, which houses Michelangelo’s statue of Moses, as well as the chains that may have bound Peter. Next, we will visit Tres Fontane Abbey, the traditional location where the Apostle Paul was martyred. Here we will have a special communion service. Afterwards we make a visit to St. Paul’s Church where Paul is buried. Dinner and overnight are in Rome.

**Day 15 – Friday, September 11: Depart Rome, Arrive U.S.A.**  
We transfer to the Rome Airport for our flights back home.
