Taxes and fuel charges totaling **\$695 USD** comprised of **\$364.60** for fuel charges (subject to airline increase up to 30-days before departure) and **\$330.40** for taxes (including U.S. federal inspection fees, airport taxes international air transportation tax, agricultural tax, other government-imposed fees such as the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person).

**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:**  
Passports, visas, vaccinations (if required), laundry, lunches not on the tour menu (food outside of the contracted menu will be billed prior to leaving the hotel or restaurant), excursions not listed, telephone/international data, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, excess baggage fees, additional airline fees after registration, travel insurance, and all other items not explicitly mentioned.

**PAYMENTS & FEES:**  
**A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is due upon registration, with a second deposit of \$500 per person required within 21 days thereafter.** Credit cards are only accepted for the initial \$500 deposit; subsequent payments must be in check, ACH transfer, bill payment, or wire transfer; **all payments are required in US Funds.** **Final payment is due no later than 120 days prior to departure.** Registrations after 120 days require full payment and may incur a \$300 late fee if received 119-90 days before departure. **Failure to make final payment by 90 days prior to departure results in automatic cancellation, forfeiture of the \$500 deposit, and potential additional fees.** *imagine* Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as *imagine*) reserves the right to impose a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the destination currency based on booking date (11/24/25).

**GROUP SIZE & SUPPLEMENTS:**  
Tour pricing assumes a minimum group size of 20 passengers. **Smaller groups may incur supplements:**

- \$150 per person (19-16 travelers)
- \$195 per person (15-14 travelers)
- \$295 per person (13-12 travelers)

Tours with fewer than 12 travelers may be canceled due to insufficient participation.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:**  
Price is based on double occupancy (two people sharing a room). Single rooms may be smaller than double rooms and, when available, incur **an additional supplemental charge of \$949 for the basic itinerary.** Roommates are assigned if available; otherwise, single-room occupancy may apply. *Roommates may be assigned as late as 120 days prior to departure when applicable.*

**ITINERARY & CHANGES:**  
*imagine* reserves the right to adjust itineraries due to airline schedule changes. Changes requiring extra nights incur \$195 per person per night (\$295 for single rooms). You will be notified in writing of said changes when possible. Meals for additional overnights are not included. Changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing no later than 120 days prior to departure. **All deviations are subject to a \$250 administrative fee** plus applicable airline fees. **All tours are made final at 90 days prior to departure.** **No changes (including additions) may be made after this time.**

**LAND ONLY:**  
**Land Only price is \$3,647 per person, excluding international flights.** Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. Passengers changing from the regular tour (with group airfare) to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$195 per person.

**AIRLINE TICKETS & SEATING:**  
Flight routing is at the sole discretion of the airline, not *imagine*. *imagine* does not guarantee passengers will be on the most direct flight or flying together to the final destination (especially prior to 120 days of departure). Flights are economy class on IATA/ARC carriers with non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more. Due to group rates, *imagine* does not participate or allow passengers to use points, miles, or other airline-related

offerings on group contracted airfare. Seating requests are at the discretion of the applicable airline and cannot be guaranteed. All requests, including seating, dietary restrictions, and/or all other accommodations must be made in writing prior to 120 days of departure. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after 120 days prior to departure will incur additional fees. Individual ticketing fees/deposits may apply in certain situations. **These fees can be up to \$2,000 per person and will be applied to your final balance.**

**FLIGHT TIMES:**  
**All flight times are subject to change without notice. *imagine* is not liable for expenses resulting from flight delays or changes.** If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend obtaining a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

**PASSPORTS & VISAS:**  
Passengers must ensure their **passports are valid for at least six months beyond the return date of their trip** and submit a valid passport copy to our office no later than 120 days prior to departure. Visa requirements vary by country, and it is each passenger's responsibility to obtain necessary visas prior to travel. ***imagine* is not liable for obtaining any required travel visas.**

**TRIP RESCHEDULING:**  
*imagine* and/or the group leader/organization reserves the right to reschedule the trip to **future dates and/or a different destination** due to governmental action, pandemics, wars, or other circumstances beyond their control. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates or to the updated destination may transfer to another tour within one year of the original travel dates, subject to fees of up to \$300 per person, plus any applicable fees imposed by ground operators, airlines, or other vendors.

**CANCELLATION FEES:**  
Passengers cancelling from the day of registration up to 121 days prior to departure **will be charged a \$500 administrative fee** plus any airline penalties, if applicable. If passenger cancellation forces a roommate into a single room, the canceled passenger may be charged their single room fee. **⬆ (see Accommodations)**

ITINERARY

**Day 1 – Tuesday, January 12: Depart U.S.A.**  
Tour members meet for our flight to Israel. After dinner, relax and enjoy on-board entertainment as we prepare for this exciting adventure.

**Day 2 – Wednesday, January 13: Arrive in Tel Aviv**  
In Tel Aviv, after proceeding through customs, we’re met by our tour guide. From here, we drive to our hotel in Tel Aviv for dinner and overnight.

**Day 3 – Thursday, January 14: Caesarea, Megiddo, Mt. Carmel, Nazareth, Cana, Galilee**  
We start by traveling to Caesarea Maritima (Acts 10), then venture to Megiddo and Mt. Carmel (1 Kings 18). If time allows, we’ll visit a Druze Village for lunch (not included). Afterwards, we continue to Nazareth (Jesus’ childhood home), then Cana (Jesus’ first miracle - John 2), concluding our day atop Mt. Precipice. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias near the Sea of Galilee.

**Day 4 – Friday, January 15: Galilee, Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Boat Ride, Bethsaida, Jordan River**  
This morning, experience the sunrise over the Sea of Galilee! We then begin our day at Tabgha (feeding of the 5000) and the Church of the Primacy of St. Peter. We read the Sermon on the Mount at the Mt. of Beatitudes, then travel downhill to Capernaum (Jesus’ ministry base). Venturing to Ginosar, we sail on the Sea of Galilee in a replica “Jesus Boat.” Lunch features the option to try an authentic St. Peter’s Fish (not included)! After lunch, we visit Gadara and Bethsaida (time permitting) before heading to the Jordan River. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

**Day 5 – Saturday, January 16: Golan Heights, Caesarea Philippi, Tel Dan, Gideon Springs, Beit Shean, Jerusalem**  
Today we travel north to the Golan Heights for stunning views, then to Caesarea Philippi where Peter confessed, “You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God” (Matthew 16:13-16). We take a hike through Tel Dan to see the altar of Jeroboam and then visit Gideon Springs. Traveling south, we explore Beit Shean, where King Saul’s body was hung (1 Samuel 31:10-12). This evening, we ascend to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. “I was glad when they said to me, ‘Let us go to the house of the Lord.’ Our feet are standing within your gates, O Jerusalem” (Psalm 122:1-2).

**Day 6 – Sunday, January 17: Mt. of Olives, Palm Sunday Road, Garden of Gethsemane, Western Wall, Temple Mount, Via Dolorosa, Southern Steps, Bethlehem**  
The day begins on the Mt. of Olives with a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Here we travel to the Garden of

Gethsemane and the Church of the Agony via the Palm Sunday Road. Enter Jerusalem, the “Old City”, through the Zion Gate to the Western Wall (the holiest site in Judaism) and Temple Mount purchased by King David (2 Samuel 24:18-25). We walk the Via Dolorosa, including stops at St. Anne’s Church, Pools of Bethesda, the Pavement, and the Ecce Homo Arch. We conclude our walk at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, then travel down to the original steps Jesus climbed as he entered the Temple Area. We finish with a visit to Bethlehem, passing by Rachel’s tomb on our way to the Church of the Nativity, and Shepherds’ Field. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**Day 7 – Monday, January 18: Qumran, Ein Gedi, Masada, Dead Sea for Swim/Float**  
This morning, we drive down to Qumran, home of the Dead Sea Scrolls. From here, we head to Ein Gedi (where David hid from Saul), then travel to Masada to scale King Herod’s fortress (via cable car). Before returning to Jerusalem, we stop at the renowned Dead Sea for a swim or float. Time permitting, we’ll stop and visit Qasr el-Yahud (the traditional site of Jesus’ baptism) and possibly Jericho. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**Day 8 – Tuesday, January 19: Shrine of the Book, Model City, City of David, Hezekiah’s Tunnel, Pool of Siloam, St. Peter Gallicantu, Garden Tomb**  
Today, we visit the Shrine of the Book Museum to see the Dead Sea Scrolls (found in Qumran) and a 1:50 scale model of Jerusalem from Jesus’ time. Afterwards, we explore the City of David and walk through Hezekiah’s Tunnel (bring a flashlight and water shoes). Anyone wishing to stay dry can walk through Hezekiah’s Shaft. If time permits, visit the newly excavated Pool of Siloam and St. Peter in Gallicantu. We end a perfect day with worship at Golgotha and the Garden Tomb. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

**Day 9 – Wednesday, January 20: Jerusalem, Elah Valley, Jaffa, Farewell Dinner**  
Leisure time in Jerusalem this morning before venturing to the Elah Valley where David slew Goliath. Afterwards, we travel to Jaffa for a visit of the Old City and then return to Jerusalem for our last overnight and Farewell Dinner.

**Day 10 – Thursday, January 21: Ben Gurion Airport , Arrive in U.S.A.**  
From here, we transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our flight back to the U.S.A. Arriving back in the U.S.A., we take home wonderful memories, renewed faith, and a greater understanding of our Lord’s life.



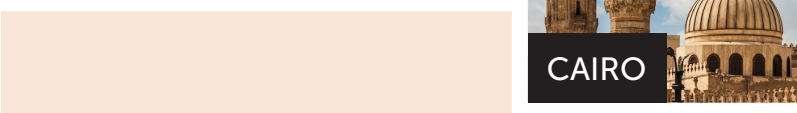

**Day 10 – Thursday, January 21: Arrive in Egypt**  
Our Egyptian adventure begins as we cross the Taba border. Before tomorrow’s ancient explorations, we’ll settle into our hotel in St. Catherine, enjoy dinner, and rest.

**Day 11 – Friday, January 22: Mount Moussa, St. Catherine’s Monastery, Fly to Cairo**  
In the early morning hours, we will gather in the hotel lobby (2:00 a.m.) to begin our ascent of Mount Moussa, the biblical Mountain of Moses, where tradition holds that Moses received the Ten Commandments. Those who choose not to climb can relax at the hotel. The climb, following the Path of Moses with its nearly 4,000 steps, will take about three hours, culminating in a breathtaking sunrise at the peak. After descending, we will visit St. Catherine’s Monastery, built around what is believed to be the site of the Burning Bush, and home to priceless works of art. Later, we will transfer to Sharm El Sheikh airport for a short flight to Cairo, where we check into our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Day 12 – Saturday, January 23: Cairo, Great Pyramids, Sphinx, Memphis**  
After breakfast, we will explore some of Egypt’s most iconic ancient sites. We will begin at the Pyramids of Giza, where we will marvel at the Great Pyramid of Cheops, enter the King’s Chamber, and visit the Solar Boat Museum to see a 4,500-year-old cedar wood boat. Nearby these pyramids stands the majestic Great Sphinx. Next, we will visit the Necropolis of Saqqara to see King Zoser’s Step Pyramid, the oldest stone pyramid in Egypt. Our day will conclude in Memphis, the ancient capital of Egypt, where we will view the impressive limestone Colossus of Ramses II. We return to Cairo for dinner and overnight.

**Day 13 – Sunday, January 24: Cairo**  
Our day will begin with a visit to the Museum of Antiquities, home to the world’s largest collection of Pharaonic treasures, including the famous golden treasures of Tutankhamen. We will then proceed to the Citadel, where we will explore the opulent Alabaster Mosque of Muhammad Ali. Our journey continues with visits to the ancient Suspended Church and the Church of St. Sergius, built over the cave where the Holy Family is believed to have stayed. We will also visit the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, where, according to tradition, Moses was saved by Pharaoh’s daughter. Finally, we will stroll through the lively Khan El Khalili Bazaar, a bustling market full of traditional crafts and souvenirs, before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Day 14 – Monday, January 25: Depart Cairo**  
On our final day, we will transfer to Cairo Airport for our return flight to the U.S.A., arriving home later the same day, carrying with us the memories of our remarkable journey through Egypt.
