Airfare, passports, visa/ETA, vaccinations (if required), laundry, lunches not on the tour menu (food outside the contracted menu will be billed prior to leaving the hotel or restaurant), excursions not listed, telephone/international data, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, excess baggage fees, additional airline fees after registration, travel insurance, and all other items not explicitly mentioned.

**PAYMENTS & FEES:**

A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is due upon registration, with a second deposit of \$500 per person required within 21 days thereafter.

Credit cards are only accepted for the initial \$500 deposit; subsequent payments must be in check, ACH transfer, bill payment, or wire transfer; **all payments are required in US Funds.**

**Final payment is due no later than 120 days prior to departure.**

Registrations after 120 days require full payment and may incur a \$300 late fee if received 119-90 days before departure. **Failure to make final payment by 90 days prior to departure results in automatic cancellation, forfeiture of the \$500 deposit, and potential additional fees.**

imagine Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as *imagine*) reserves the right to impose a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the destination currency based on booking date (12/03/25).

**GROUP SIZE & SUPPLEMENTS:**

Tour pricing assumes a minimum group size of 20 passengers.

**Smaller groups may incur supplements:**

- \$150 per person (19-16 travelers)
- \$195 per person (15-14 travelers)
- \$295 per person (13-12 travelers)

Tours with fewer than 12 travelers may be canceled due to insufficient participation.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:**

Price is based on double occupancy (two people sharing a room). Single rooms may be smaller than double rooms and, when available, incur an additional supplemental charge of \$949 for the basic itinerary. Roommates are assigned if available; otherwise, single-room occupancy may apply. Roommates may be assigned as late as 120 days prior to departure when applicable.

**ITINERARY & CHANGES:**

*imagine* reserves the right to adjust itineraries due to airline schedule changes. Changes requiring extra nights incur \$195 per person per night (\$295 for single rooms). You will be notified in writing of said changes when possible. Meals for additional overnights are not included. Changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing no later than 120 days prior to departure. **All deviations are subject to a \$250 administrative fee plus applicable airline fees. All tours are made final at 90 days prior to departure.** No changes (including additions) may be made after this time.

**LAND ONLY:****Land Only price is \$4,097 per person, excluding international flights.**

Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. Passengers changing from the regular tour (with group airfare) to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$195 per person.

**AIRLINE TICKETS & SEATING:**

Flight routing is at the sole discretion of the airline, not *imagine*. *imagine* does not guarantee passengers will be on the most direct flight or flying together to the final destination (especially prior to 120 days of departure). Flights are economy class on IATA/ARC carriers with non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more. Due to group rates, *imagine* does not participate or allow passengers to use points, miles, or other airline-related offerings on group contracted airfare. Seating requests are at the discretion of the applicable airline and cannot be guaranteed. All requests, including seating, dietary restrictions, and all other accommodations must be made in writing prior to 120 days of departure. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after 120 days prior to departure will incur additional fees. Individual ticketing fees/deposits may apply in certain situations. **These fees**

**FLIGHT TIMES:**

All flight times are subject to change without notice. *imagine* is not liable for expenses resulting from flight delays or changes. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend obtaining a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

**PASSPORTS & VISAS:**

Passengers must ensure their **passports are valid for at least six months beyond the return date of their trip** and submit a valid passport copy to our office no later than 120 days prior to departure. Visa requirements vary by country, and it is each passenger's responsibility to obtain necessary visas prior to travel. *imagine* is not liable for obtaining any required travel visas.

**TRIP RESCHEDULING:**

*imagine* and/or the group leader/organization reserves the right to reschedule the trip to **future dates and/or a different destination** due to governmental action, pandemics, wars, or other circumstances beyond their control. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates or to the updated destination may transfer to another tour within one year of the original travel dates, subject to fees of up to \$300 per person, plus any applicable fees imposed by ground operators, airlines, or other vendors.

**CANCELLATION FEES:**

Passengers cancelling from the day of registration up to 121 days prior to departure **will be charged a \$500 administrative fee** plus any airline penalties, if applicable. If passenger cancellation forces a roommate into a single room, the canceled passenger may be charged the single room fee. **(see Accommodations)**

The following charges also apply: (plus airline fees, when applicable)

- \$1,500 (120 – 91 days)
- \$2,750 (90 – 75 days)
- **85% of total tour cost (74 – 60 days)**
- **100% of total tour cost (59 days to day of departure)**

**All cancellations must be submitted in writing.** No refunds will be provided for unused services on or after the day of departure. We advise purchasing travel insurance. In the event *imagine* cancels the tour due to insufficient participation, a \$200 administrative fee per passenger will be deducted from any applicable refund, plus any airline penalties.

**Changes to the tour cannot be made within 90 days of departure, as the tour is considered closed at that time.**



# The ITINERARY

## Day 1 – Tuesday, January 26: Depart U.S.A.

Tour members meet for our flight to Israel. After dinner, relax and enjoy on-board entertainment as we prepare for this exciting adventure.

## Day 2 – Wednesday, January 27: Arrive in Tel Aviv

In Tel Aviv, after proceeding through customs, we're met by our tour guide. From here, we drive to our hotel in Netanya for dinner and overnight.

## Day 3 – Thursday, January 28: Caesarea Maritima, Megiddo, Nazareth, Cana, Galilee

We start by traveling to Caesarea Maritima (Acts 10), then venture to Megiddo. If time allows, we'll visit a Druze Village for lunch (not included). Afterwards, we continue to Nazareth (Jesus' childhood home), then Cana (Jesus' first miracle - John 2), concluding our day atop Mt. Precipice. Dinner and overnight are in Tiberias near the Sea of Galilee.

## Day 4 – Friday, January 29: Galilee, Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Boat Ride, Bethsaida, Jordan River

This morning, experience the sunrise over the Sea of Galilee! We then begin our day at Tabgha (feeding of the 5000) and the Church of the Primacy of St. Peter. We read the Sermon on the Mount at the Mt. of Beatitudes, then travel downhill to Capernaum (Jesus' ministry base). Venturing to Ginosar, we sail on the Sea of Galilee in a replica "Jesus Boat." Lunch features the option to try an authentic St. Peter's Fish (not included)! After lunch, we visit Gadara and Bethsaida (time permitting) before heading to the Jordan River. Dinner and overnight are in Tiberias.

## Day 5 – Saturday, January 30: Golan Heights, Caesarea Philippi, Tel Dan, Gideon Springs, Beit Shean, Jerusalem

Today we travel north to the Golan Heights for stunning views, then to Caesarea Philippi where Peter confessed, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:13-16). We take a hike through Tel Dan to see the altar of Jeroboam and then visit Gideon Springs. Traveling south, we explore Beit Shean, where King Saul's body was hung (1 Samuel 31:10-12). This evening, we ascend to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. "I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord.' Our feet are standing within your gates, O Jerusalem" (Psalm 122:1-2).

## Day 6 – Sunday, January 31: Mt. of Olives, Palm Sunday Road, Garden of Gethsemane, Western Wall, Temple Mount, Via Dolorosa, Davidson Center and Southern Steps

The day begins on the Mt. of Olives with a panoramic

view of Jerusalem. Here, we travel to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of the Agony via the Palm Sunday Road. Enter Jerusalem, the "Old City", through the Zion Gate to the Western Wall (the holiest site in Judaism) and Temple Mount purchased by King David (2 Samuel 24:18-25). We walk the Via Dolorosa, including stops at St. Anne's Church, Pools of Bethesda, the Pavement, and the Ecce Homo Arch. We conclude our walk at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, then travel down to the Davidson Center, including the original steps Jesus climbed as he entered the Temple Area, the Southern Steps. We will end the day at the Shorashim Shop. Dinner and overnight are in Jerusalem.

## Day 7 – Monday, February 1: Qumran, Ein Gedi, Masada, Dead Sea for Swim/Float

This morning, we drive down to Qumran, home of the Dead Sea Scrolls. From here, we head to Ein Gedi (where David hid from Saul), then travel to Masada to scale King Herod's fortress (via cable car). Before returning to Jerusalem, we stop at the renowned Dead Sea for a swim or float. Time permitting, we'll stop and visit Qasr el-Yahud (the traditional site of Jesus' baptism) and possibly Jericho. Dinner and overnight are in Jerusalem.

## Day 8 – Tuesday, February 2: Shrine of the Book, Model City, City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel, Pool of Siloam, St. Peter Gallicantu, Garden Tomb

Today, we visit the Shrine of the Book Museum to see the Dead Sea Scrolls (found in Qumran) and a 1:50 scale model of Jerusalem from Jesus' time. Afterwards, we explore the City of David and visit Hezekiah's Tunnel. If time permits, we'll visit the newly excavated Pool of Siloam and St. Peter in Gallicantu. We end a perfect day with worship at Golgotha and the Garden Tomb. Dinner and overnight are in Jerusalem.

## Day 9 – Wednesday, February 3: Jerusalem, Herodion, Bethlehem, David's Citadel


After breakfast, we depart Jerusalem and drive south to visit the national park of Herodion, the grave of King Herod. Then we proceed to visit Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity and Shepherds' Field. Afterwards, we return to Jerusalem to visit David's Citadel with its new museum. Last overnight and Farewell Dinner are at our hotel in Jerusalem.

## Day 10 – Thursday, February 4: Ben Gurion Airport, Arrive in U.S.A.

From here, we transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our flight back to the U.S.A. Arriving back in the U.S.A., we take home wonderful memories, renewed faith, and a greater understanding of our Lord's life.

## Day 10 – Thursday, February 4: Allenby Bridge, Jordan: Tall El Hammam, Mt. Nebo

After breakfast, we cross the Jordan River at the Allenby Bridge to enter the Kingdom of Jordan. We visit Tall el-Hammam to explore the site recently suggested as the ancient city of Sodom. We ascend to the top of Mount Nebo to view the Promised Land from the same perspective as Moses. Afterwards, we drive south into the mountains of Edom to our hotel near Petra. Dinner and overnight are in Wadi Musa.

## Day 11 – Friday, February 5: Petra, Madaba

Today we venture into the rose-red city of Petra! Here, we spend the day marveling at the stunning beauty of the Siq (entrance passage), the Treasury, the Street of Facades, the 8000-seat Theater, and the various temples and royal tombs carved into the red stone. We then drive north along the King's Highway to our hotel on the northeast shore of the Dead Sea. En route, we will stop at Madaba, the site of the oldest map of Palestine in the world. Dinner and overnight are in Sweimeh.

## Day 12 – Saturday, February 6: Flight to Cairo, Felucca Boat Ride, Grand Egyptian Museum

After breakfast, we transfer to the Queen Alia International Airport for our flight to Egypt (flight included). Upon arrival we will be met by our guide to begin our tour. First, we enjoy a felucca boat ride on the waters of the Nile. Then we enjoy a special tour of the new Grand Egyptian Museum. The museum houses the greatest collection of Pharaonic treasures in the world, including the expansive Tutankhamen collection of golden treasures.

## Day 13 – Sunday, February 7: Cairo, Great Pyramids, Sphinx, Memphis

After breakfast, we venture to visit some of Egypt's oldest sites and enjoy a camel ride. We first visit the Pyramids of Giza. The Great Pyramid of Cheops is the largest and is comprised of 2.3 million stone blocks. We enter this pyramid and visit the King's Chamber. Nearby, we visit the Solar Boat Museum, to see an ancient Egyptian cedar wood boat dating back 4,500 years. We also visit the Great Sphinx. Then, we visit the Necropolis of Sakkara, to see King Zoser's Step Pyramid. This vast site in the heart of the desert plateau is the largest necropolis in Egypt. We end in Memphis, to see the limestone Colossus of Ramses II. Here, the remnants of the nation's first capital and once the most cosmopolitan city in Egypt now lie scattered in the desert. Dinner and overnight are in Cairo.

## Day 14 – Monday, February 8: Cairo Today we visit the Citadel

Inside, we see the lavishly decorated Alabaster Mosque of Mohammed Ali. We continue to the famous Suspended Church, dating back to the late fourth and early fifth centuries. We then visit the Church of St. Sergius, a fifth-century Coptic church built in the cave where the Holy Family stayed. We come to the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, where Moses was saved by Pharaoh's water girl. Finally, we stroll through the Khan El Khalili Bazaar, a bustling warren of shops where you can bargain for rugs, copper, leather crafts, and much more. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

## Day 15 – Tuesday, February 9: Transfer to Cairo Airport

This morning, we transfer to the airport to make our way home after an unforgettable adventure!
