**Enrollment in and payment of your deposit for the tour, constitutes your acceptance of the conditions and statement of responsibility.**

**INCLUDED IN PRICE:** 1) Round trip airfare per brochure, deluxe motor coaches, Superior Tourist/First class hotels throughout & 3 star accommodations in Oberammergau area, guided sightseeing, entrance fees to sites visited, breakfast & dinner daily, plus dinner at Oberammergau Village; 2) Taxes and fuel charges totaling **\$590 USD** comprised of **\$259.60** for fuel charges (subject to increase by airline up to 30 days prior to departure) and **\$330.40** for taxes (including federal inspection fees for the U.S. Customs and Immigrations; international air transportation tax; agricultural tax; other per person taxes imposed by government entities; airport taxes and fees including the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person); 3) Gratuities of **\$175** for tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew; gratuities on ferries, and cruise ships.

**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:** Not included in your package are passports, visas, vaccinations, laundry, lunches, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, and all other items not specifically mentioned.

**PAYMENT:** A full deposit of **\$500 per person** is required at time of registration. A second deposit of **\$500 per person** is required within 14 days of initial registration. A third deposit of **\$500 per person** is required no later than 180 days prior to departure. Final payment must be made in the form of a check and is due no later than **120-days prior to departure**. (Credit cards are only accepted for initial deposit, any remaining payments must be in check form.) Registrations received after 120-days prior to departure **must be accompanied by full payment**. There may be a late fee of **\$195 for all payments or new registrations received 110-90 days prior to departure**. All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 36 passengers for prices to be valid. If group size is 35-30 travelers, a \$105 per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is 29-25 travelers, a \$220 per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is 24-20 travelers, a \$390 per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is less than 20 travelers, a per person supplement to price will be determined. If group size is less than 12 travelers the tour may be cancelled due to lack of participation. If final (full) payment is not received by **Imagine Tours and Travel, LLC** (hereafter referred to as **Imagine**) 90-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your deposit of \$1500 will be forfeited. **Imagine** reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2.5% against the Euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on 5/3/17 (Pricing based on exchange of the Euro to US Dollar on this date at conversion of 1.10 exchange). All payments are required in US Dollars.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While **Imagine** will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 60 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a **single room supplement charge: \$495 for basic itinerary**. **ITINERARY and CHANGES:** Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, **Imagine** reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing to **Imagine** no later than 120-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger. All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. **All tours are final at 90-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.**

**LAND ONLY:** Land Only price is **\$4177 per person**. Price does not include international flights. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

**AIRLINE TICKETS:** In order to keep prices low, **Imagine** does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. **Imagine** also does not guarantee the group will be on the same flights. Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not **Imagine**. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once issued. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. **Imagine** is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights, could result in different routings/air carriers.

**VISAS:** Applicable visas will be obtained by **Imagine** for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. **Imagine** is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

**FLIGHT TIMES:** All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. **Imagine** is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. Passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

**CANCELLATION FEES:** If the tour is cancelled due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$150 deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees plus any airline penalties if applicable. Any passenger cancelling from day of registration to 180 days prior to departure will be charged a **\$500 non-refundable administrative fee per person** plus any airline penalties, if applicable (regardless of reason for cancelling). You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room. The following charges also apply: 179-155 days = \$1000; 154-91 days = \$1500; 90-75 days = 75% of total cost; 74 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. **All Cancellations must be received in writing.** On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. **We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance (please see the box below).**

## THE PROMISE

In 1633 the Black Plague rampaged through Europe, killing thousands. For months, the small village of Oberammergau managed to keep the dreaded disease at bay, mainly because of its remote location in the Bavarian Alps. Eventually the epidemic struck the nearby town of Ettal. The people of Oberammergau, however, controlled the spread of the disease by keeping close watch and preventing strangers from entering their village. Alas, late one evening, a villager who had been away, homesick for his family, strolled back into the town unknowingly brought the plague to his people. Within a few months, 84 villagers had died.

In July of 1633 the survivors gathered and made a solemn oath to God: if He spared them from further deaths, they would perform every ten years a day-long play depicting Jesus' death and Resurrection. According to the story passed down through the generations, God heard them and there were no more deaths. In 1634, the townspeople performed their **Passion Play** for the first time. Eventually their vow was adopted by their children and their descendants. To this day, the villagers of Oberammergau have kept their promise virtually unbroken.

*Our Oberammergau tour will help us discover "geborgenheit, gesundheit, gemutlichkeit." Loosely the 3 words mean "hospitality, health, happiness." All these words express what we have received through Christ and are the fruit of the Spirit. Our tour begins in Schladming for four nights to help us discover the meaning of these words and then as we progress to the Passion story in Oberammergau, the spirit of the first part of the tour will overflow into the experience of that drama.*

### DAY 1 – WEDNESDAY, MAY 25: DEPART U.S.A.

Tour members depart America on our flight to Munich. After we board our flight for Europe, we will be served dinner according to the airline's schedule. Sit-back, relax and enjoy the onboard entertainment.

### DAY 2 – THURSDAY, MAY 26: ARRIVAL IN GERMANY, SCHLADMING (AUSTRIA)

After arrival at Munich airport, we will be met by our tour escort who will lead us to our coach. Our drive to Schladming in Austria will take about 4 hours. We check-in at our hotel and have some time on our own to relax or to explore the surroundings of our hotel. We will meet in the party room for a special 'get acquainted' time which will include evening prayer as we prepare for the passion play. Overnight is in Schladming.

### DAY 3 – FRIDAY, MAY 27: SCHLADMING

Morning Prayer with the Daily Texts begins the day followed by a luscious breakfast. Afterwards, there will be options for a hike to a waterfall or on a mountain trail, getting a massage, swimming, or taking a sauna in the Spa area of the hotel. In the afternoon, we will visit the Church Museum on the history of Lutheranism and the counter-Reformation in the Schladming Valley. After our four-course dinner we will experience a slide show on the 12 seasons of the Schladming Valley. We will close the day with evening prayer.

### DAY 4 – SATURDAY, MAY 28: SALZBURG, SCHLADMING

During our excursion of today we see the great city of Salzburg, the hometown of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. We start our tour with visits to Mozart's Birth House and Mozart's Residence. The house in which the great composer was born in 1756 is now one of the most frequently visited museums in the world. No other place where the person behind the artist and his music can be experienced as well as at his birthplace. At Mozart's Residence, the biographies of the family members and the authentic impressions of everyday family life are displayed. Later you will get an overview of the most popular sights and some of the original filming locations of the film and musical "The Sound of Music". You will see the Carillon, Salzburg Cathedral, Franciscan Church, Mozart Square, Hofstallgasse, St. Peter's Abbey, and Mirabell Palace and Gardens in baroque style. After the lunchbreak, a cable car takes us up to Hohensalzburg fortress. We explore one of the biggest castles in Europe with an audio-guide. After going down again by cable car our coach brings us back to our hotel in Schladming for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 5 – SUNDAY, MAY 29: SCHLADMING

On this Sunday morning, we will gather for Worship at our hotel. Afterwards we can take part in several activities. Hiking will be available, or it is a gift to sit on the veranda of the hotel and take in the gorgeous mountain views front and back. The incredible Spa will be open as well. We will have our third preparation for the Passion Play. Another feast of dinner will be enjoyed on the close of this Sabbath day.

### DAY 6 – MONDAY, MAY 30: MAINAU ISLAND, CONSTANCE

We depart our place of Geborgenheit, Gesundheit, and Gemutlichkeit; Schutterhof! We travel by coach through the famous landscape of the Alps. After several hours, we finally reach Lake Constance. We cross over the border to Germany, follow the north banks of the lake and come to the picturesque island Mainau, which is famous for its parks and gardens. The smell of flowers will accompany us during our guided tour on the island. We then come to Constance, check-in at the hotel, and have dinner. Overnight is in Constance.

### DAY 7 – TUESDAY, MAY 31: LUCERNE

After breakfast, we leave Germany and come to Switzerland. It is just a short way as Lake Constance belongs to three countries: Germany, Austria, and Switzerland. We head to Lucerne, located on the banks of Lake Lucerne. The "Golden Circle Tour" will bring us by boat, cable car, rack rail and bus to Alpnachstad, to the peak of Mount Pilatus, to Kulm, to Kriens, and back to Lucerne. Dinner will be at the restaurant "Stadtkeller" where we enjoy a national specialty: the cheese fondue. Overnight is in Lucerne.

### DAY 8 – WEDNESDAY, JUNE 1: NEUSCHWANSTEIN, OBERAMMERGAU

This day is dedicated to the most famous castle of Bavaria. We visit Neuschwanstein Castle from the outside and from the inside. On our way, we will have a stop at the border to the Principality Liechtenstein. A very nice stamp in our passport will confirm that we visited one of the smallest countries in Europe. Neuschwanstein is the most visited castle of Germany, perched high up on a mountain in the beautiful landscape of the Alps. The shimmering white towers of the castle among the clouds are instantly recognizable to many and are the inspiration for Disney's Sleeping Beauty Castle. To visit it is to step inside a fairy tale. We also have the opportunity to visit the Museum of the Bavarian Kings and learn about royal history. After the visit, we continue to a small, picturesque village in the Alps which is known all over the world: Oberammergau, the "Passion Play village with heart." Dinner and overnight is in the Oberammergau area.

### DAY 9 – THURSDAY, JUNE 2: OBERAMMERGAU, THE PLAY

Oberammergau is not only known for its World-Famous Passion Play, but also for its woodcarving craft and for its colorful and attractive frescos known as Lüftlmalereien. In the morning, we have time to explore the lovely village, the museum, the parish church and a woodcarving workshop. Then we should take our seat at the Passion Play Theater for the early afternoon performance. All the actors, musicians, and singers as well as the backstage staff are either born in Oberammergau or been residents for more than 20 years. Between the different scenes of the life of Jesus Christ we can admire "living pictures" – scenes from the Bible presented as still life. After 2.5 hours, it is time for a dinner break, which is waiting for us in a local restaurant. After dinner, we have the opportunity to stroll around in the village and to do some shopping. Later this evening, the second part of the play starts and will end at approximately 11:00 pm. We go back to our hotel in the Oberammergau area for overnight after the play.



### DAY 10 – FRIDAY, JUNE 3: MUNICH, DACHAU, ERDING

This morning we continue to Munich, where we enjoy a walking tour through the historic Old City of Munich. It consists of famous buildings and squares, including the Marienplatz with the town hall and its "Glockenspiel" along with the "Frauenkirche" (Church of our Lady) with its distinctive onion dome towers. And of course, we will walk through the Viktualienmarkt. From the outside will we see Deutsches Museum and Nymphenburg Palace. After lunchbreak, we drive south to Dachau. Dachau was the first Nazi concentration camp, where over 200,000 prisoners were sent during World War II. We experience the history through photographs and the Dachau memorial. Dinner and overnight are in Erding, not far from Munich airport.

### DAY 11 – SATURDAY, JUNE 4: DEPART MUNICH, ARRIVE IN U.S.A.

This morning we check-out of our hotel and transfer to Munich airport for our return flight back home. We return home the same day with wonderful memories of our unique experience in Germany!
